Georgia Southern Student Awarded Prestigious Grant



Georgia Southern Student, Martin Muinos, was recently awarded a National Science Foundation Graduate Research Fellowship Program award to continue his research in the Mechanical Engineering department under the supervision of Dr. Valentin Soloiu.

During his two years as an undergraduate researcher, Martin published 4 peer reviewed papers and had over 10 posters and presentations, two of which he received merit recognition diplomas. He also won two undergraduate grants with his projects and was the lead undergraduate researcher in Dr. Soloiu's lab.

After receiving a Master degree in Mechanical Engineering, Energy Science at GSU, Martin plans to pursue a PhD in the automotive field or become a researcher at one of the National Labs in U.S.

Dr. Soloiu describes Martin as a generous and compassionate person that understands the values of sharing and outreach to the communities within the state of Georgia.
