“Positive Cases” = Reports to the CARES center by students and employees who have self reported they have tested positive for COVID-19, PLUS numbers of positive results that have come back from tests that the university has administered.

**“University Confirmed”** = The number of positive results that have come back from tests ordered by Athletics or by University Health Services.

\* **“Self Reported”** = Calls or forms submitted to CARES Center from individuals who claimed to have received a positive COVID-19 test result.

**“By Role”** = Primary role at Georgia Southern University as reported by respondents (**“Employees”** = faculty and staff).

**“By Campus”** = Self reported “home” campus by students or employees regardless of their physical presence on that campus.

**“Day Total”** = Total number of positive cases logged into the CARES Center per day.

**“Weekly Cumulative Total”** = Total number of positive cases – both university confirmed and self-reported – logged into the CARES Center per week.
