Dancing

Ballet dancing is taught under the instruction of Ebba Thomson, outstanding dancing teacher in Savannah. The classes are divided into two groups, upper and lower. Basic and fundamental ballet steps are a part of the regular routine. One lesson a month is set aside for the study of the more famous ballets. In this way the pupils get a better idea of both the story and the music, and can appreciate the fine art of dancing.


