2014 NSF Proposal & Award Policies & Procedures Guide

The National Science Foundation has released the it's new proposal and award guide for 2014. Effective for proposals submitted on or after February 24, 2014, the updated Proposal and Award Policy and Procedures Guide (PAPP) offers guidance on the preparation and submission of proposals along with guidance on managing and administering grants and agreements with NSF. The new guide offers several significant changes including: changes to the conflict of interest disclosure process, unfunded collaborations, updates to the process for reporting program income, and many other clarifications.
