Certificates and Intensive Programs

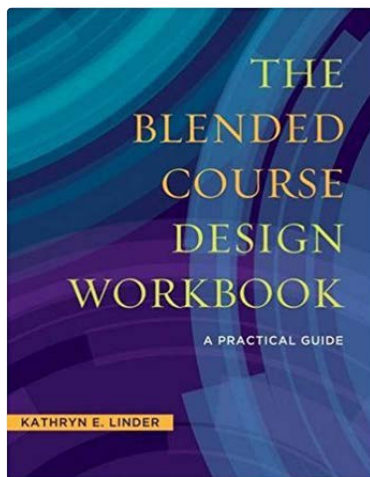
