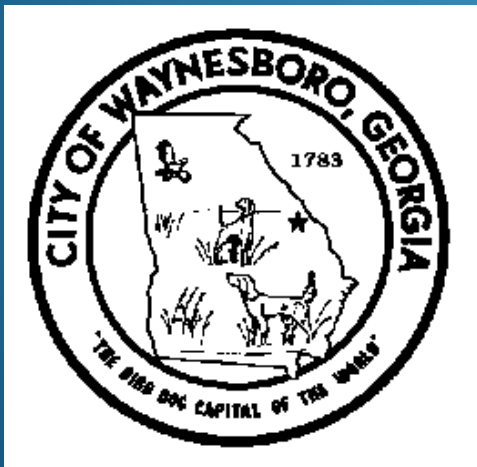


Waynesboro Sidewalk Replacement Project

Background Information

- Location: Waynesboro is located in Burke County
- Population: 5,809 (as of 2013)
- City chose to undertake a sidewalk replacement project in order to decrease liabilities to the city and make current sidewalks ADA compliant.

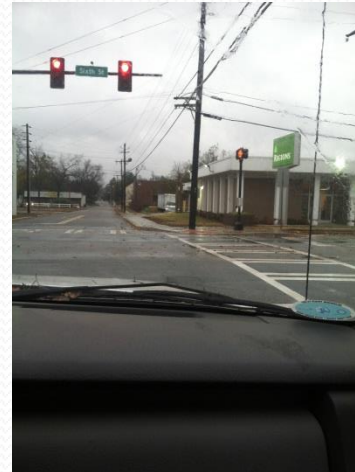
Additional Information

- City will remove current trees (at listed locations) and replace with new trees appropriate to the area between Thanksgiving and Christmas.
- 4 areas of sidewalk have been considered for Phases 2 and 3 due to:
 - Minor ADA issues
 - Less damage
 - Large tree removal efforts

Conclusion

- Waynesboro City Council approved Phase 1 of the Sidewalk Replacement Project. Phases 2 and 3 will be revisited at a later date.
 - It was suggested that once major replacements are completed Waynesboro should continue a maintenance and replacement on a regular basis.
- City Manager, Jerry Coalson, issued Notice to Proceed to contractor.
