


Graduate Headcount Enrollment

Undergraduate Enrollment by Full-time/Part-time Status



Graduate Enrollment by Full-time/Part-time Status




Undergraduate Enrollment by Ethnic Group


Graduate Enrollment by Ethnic Group





Undergraduate Georgia Enrollment by County of Origin





Graduate Georgia Enrollment by County of Origin






Total Student Credit Hours
