#### **Biographical History (2.7):**

Shirley Bell Hoffman graduated Armstrong Junior College with the class of 1951. Ms. Hoffman was Drama Club Secretary 1949-1950; Assistant to Director of the Masquers, 1950-1951; and part of the Savannah Playhouse, 1949-1950. In addition to her work as assistant to the Director, Hoffman participated in Armstrong productions as actor, stage crew, stage manager and electrician. Hoffman went on to become a professional writer.

Scope and Content Note: 27 photographs and programs from about ten plays produced by the Savannah Playhouse of Armstrong College under the direction of Carlson R. Thomas (1947-1951) form the bulk of Hoffman's papers. In four letters that accompany the collection Hoffman describes people, events and places she remembers from her Armstrong career during 1949-1951. In this letter Hoffman states some of the material which was "before my time" she received from Carlson Thomas. Hoffman donated the collection in response to a request published *in Armstrong Magazine* by Dr. Janet Stone around 1994. Dr. Stone deposited the material in the University Archives at about the time it was established, 2000.

Wray Kessel was a student at Armstrong Junior College (1938/39) and served on the Board of the Savannah Playhouse, a college-community theatre of the College. Wray stayed involved with Armstrong's theatre through the 1940s and this collection include programs and other documents about Armstrong productions from that period. In 1950 Armstrong decided to focus the theatre program on students rather than community theatre, Wray and her husband Walter Kessell were founders of The Little Theatre in 1950. Also in this repository if their collection from that venture, titled Wray and Walter Kessel Collection about Little Theatre of Savannah, Ga., 1925-2007.

Kessell's donated records about Armstrong theatre include photographs, play programs, clippings and documents related to the 1949 Drama Festival.
