The group viewed a YouTube presentation of the new product PlumX. Dean Mitchell stressed the importance of faculty setting up their Selected Works page in Digital Commons in order to received reports regarding the impact of their scholarship. Following the presentation, Ashley Lowery, gave a demonstration on how to locate the service on the library's web page and how the system operates with our institutional repository.
