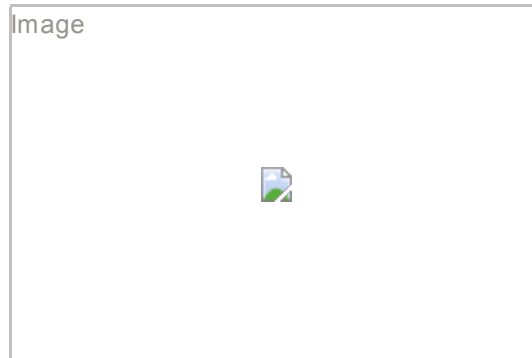

Dear Colleagues:

The National Institutes of Health (NIH) and the National Science Foundation (NSF) have released information regarding the resumption of operations since the shutdown ended. The GRC will add this information to our website along with others as they become available.

NIH

All October grant application due dates have been rescheduled as follows:

<u>Activity Code</u>	<u>Original Due Date</u>	<u>New Due Date</u>
R01s, U01s (New)	October 5	November 12
Ks (New)	October 12	November 12
R03s, R21s, R34s, R36s (New)	October 16	November 18
R15s (All)	October 25	November 18

For other opportunities with application due dates not listed above, applications are tentatively due on November 1.

The eRA Commons will be available for public access on October 21. Applications submitted since October 1 have been held at Grants.gov and will be processed by NIH's eRA systems on October 21, once NIH makes eRA systems available. Also, since October application due dates are moving to November, NIH is giving applicants who have already submitted an application for an October due date the opportunity to replace the submission with a "refreshed" application.
