Corrugated cardboard (amazon boxes)

What CANNOT be recycled?



You cannot recycle:

Styrofoam (common item found in ResHall recycling)

Glass (common item found in RasHall recycling)

Food waste (common item found in ResHall recycling)

Clothing

Sanitary products

Paperboard (such as cereal boxes)

Plastics #3-7
