EMERITUS FACULTY

President Bartels has recommended to the Board of Regents of the University System of Georgia that the following staff member and faculty members be granted emeritus status upon retirement:

Dr. Julia S. Dempsey, Assistant Professor of Nursing, will retire May 31, 2016. Dr. Dempsey earned her Bachelor of Science in Nursing (1982) from the Medical College of Georgia and her Master of Science in Nursing and Family Nurse Practitioner degree (1992) from Georgia Southern University. She earned her Doctor of Philosophy in Nursing (2014) from the Medical University of South Carolina. At the time of her retirement, she will have provided over 21 years of distinguished service to Georgia Southern University. Her research foci are Adolescent Mental Health and Community-Based Participatory Research. She has maintained her state license as a Registered Nurse for 34 years and her National Family Nurse Practitioner Certification from the American Nurses Credentialing Center for 24 years. Dr. Dempsey is a member of the National Organization of Nurse Practitioner Faculty. She has functioned as a Registered Nurse in hospital, home health, and school settings and as a Family Nurse Practitioner in health department, private practice, and academic settings. Dr. Dempsey joined the faculty at Georgia Southern University as an instructor in 1994 and was promoted to Assistant Professor in 2014. She has been a leader in implementing technology in the classroom and developing and teaching multiple on-campus, hybrid, and online courses at the undergraduate and graduate level in the School of Nursing. Dr. Dempsey has also served as clinical preceptor and clinical supervisor of graduate nurse practitioner students. In recognition of her commitment and dedicated service to the school, college, University, and profession, Dr. Julia S. Dempsey merits the title of Assistant Professor Emerita of Nursing.

Ms. Cynthia Frost, Assistant Professor in the Zach S. Henderson Library, retired June 30, 2015. Ms. Frost holds degrees from Illinois Wesleyan University (B.A., Sociology), the University of North Carolina at Chapel Hill (M.L.S.), and Emory University (D.A.S.L. and M.Ln. Librarianship). At the time of her retirement, Ms. Frost had provided 17 years of distinguished service to Georgia Southern University. Prior to coming to Georgia Southern, Ms. Frost served at Central Arkansas Library System and at the University of North Carolina at Chapel Hill. During her time at Georgia Southern, Ms. Frost served as the Head of Interlibrary Loan and led the unit through a period of enormous technological change. Thanks to her leadership, the ILLIAD system for managing interlibrary lending and borrowing of library materials was brought to Henderson Library, which made the procurement of resources from other libraries for Georgia Southern faculty and students much faster and more efficient. The Interlibrary Loan service was regularly cited by Henderson Library patrons as one of the most important and valuable resources available. Ms. Frost also assumed important Library and campus service roles, including the Provost Search Committee, Faculty Grievance Committee, Faculty Welfare Committee, Library Committee, Faculty Senate Service Committee, University Athletics Committee, Interlibrary Cooperation Roundtable, GIL Express/Interlibrary Loan Task Force, Alma Implementation Task Force, Undergraduate Committee, Distance Learning Task Force, Library Elections Committee, and the Library Collections Committee. Most notable are her collaborations with faculty from other departments leading to publications in the Georgia Journal of Science. Her service to the library profession involved the American Library Association, the Georgia Library Association, and Committee of Media Organizations. For these and other contributions to the Library, the University, and the profession, Ms. Cynthia Frost has earned the title of Assistant Professor Emerita.

Dr. Mary F. Hazeldine, Professor of Marketing, retired December 31, 2015. Dr. Hazeldine received her Bachelor of Science in Secondary Education (1971) and Master of Arts in English (1973) from Oklahoma State University. She earned her Master of Business Administration (1981) and her Doctor of Philosophy in Marketing

(1989) from the University of Texas at Arlington. She began her career in the academy as a lecturer, associate professor, and professor at California State University-San Bernadino. Joining the faculty at Georgia Southern in the fall of 1995, she completed over 20 years of distinguished service at the time of her retirement. During her tenure, Dr. Hazeldine chaired the Department of Marketing for five years and served as associate dean for the College of Business Administration for over four. In addition to her administrative service, Dr. Hazeldine maintained an active research agenda, authoring over 30 academic journal articles and numerous conference proceedings. For her research, teaching, and service, she has received numerous awards and accolades, including numerous Top Paper awards from professional conferences, an Outstanding Reviewer Award from the Journal of Marketing Theory & Practice (Association of Marketing Theory & Practice Conference, 2000), the College of Business Administration's Outstanding Service Award, and culminating in the William A. Freeman College of Business Administration Outstanding Professor. Her service to the profession included membership on the editorial review boards of the Journal of Marketing Theory and Practice, Journal of Academy of Business Administration, Decision Sciences Journal, and Journal of Business & Management. Additionally, she served as the track and session chair and conference paper reviewer for numerous academic conferences as well as a book reviewer for several books. Dr. Hazeldine has been a generous supporter of Georgia Southern academics and athletics. Notably, she created and endowed the Giacomo Family Memorial Scholarship to support the top marketing scholars at Georgia Southern. For her numerous and generous contributions to the department, college, University, and profession, Dr. Mary F. Hazeldine has earned the title of Professor Emerita of Marketing.

Ms. Janet O'Brien, Director of the Academic Success Center, is retiring July 31, 2016. Ms. O'Brien received her Bachelor of Science in Education (1982) and Master of Education (1985) from Georgia Southern College. At the time of her retirement, she will have served Georgia Southern for 33 years. She started her career teaching 7th and 8th grade math at Marvin Pittman Laboratory School on the campus of Georgia Southern. In 1984, she joined the Mathematics & Learning Support Departments of Georgia Southern as an instructor and was promoted to assistant professor in 1996. Ms. O'Brien served as the Interim Department Chair of Learning Support from 1997-2001 when she became the Director of the newly established Academic Success Center. Ms. O'Brien was very active at both the state and national levels in her profession. She served as President of the Georgia Association for Developmental Education (GADE) in 1994-1995 and 2013-2015 and has served as co-chair of the National Association for Developmental Education (NADE) Professional Job Opportunities Committee since 1998. For her service, she received the GADE Outstanding Service Award in 1999, the NADE Outstanding Service Award in 2008, and the Outstanding First Year Advocate Award from Georgia Southern in 2008. For her many contributions to the department, college, University, and profession, Ms. Janet O'Brien has earned the title of Director Emerita of the Academic Success Center.

Dr. Martha L. Schriver, Professor of Science Education, is retiring July 31, 2016. Dr. Schriver earned a B. S. degree in Secondary Education Science from Bowling Green State University (1970), a Master of Education degree in Secondary Science Education from the University of Toledo (1988), and a Ph.D. degree in Curriculum Instruction from the University of Toledo (1992). At the time of her retirement, Dr. Schriver will have provided 24 years of distinguished service to Georgia Southern University. As the Program Director of Middle Grade Education for over eight years, her commitment to improve the educational opportunities for her undergraduate stu-

dents earned her the highest respect from the departmental faculty. Throughout her career, her teaching has focused on science education, pedagogy, and scientific inquiry. During Dr. Schriver's time at Georgia Southern University, it was not uncommon to find her in her office during evening hours and on the weekends. Her dedication to her students manifested itself through her open door policy where students could seek her advice on class work, refine science projects, or seek career advice. Dr. Schriver's welcoming attitude was also extended to junior faculty who continually sought her expert guidance. Dr. Schriver is well-known in the college for her ability to secure grants to improve teacher education programs. She received an award of \$800,000 from the National Science Foundation to fund InGEAR - Integrating Gender Equity and Reform. Her passion for teaching has inspired countless numbers of science classroom teachers to engage in the conservation and preservation of Georgia's sea turtles through the funding she received from Georgia's Teacher Quality Grants. She is known college-wide for her exceptionally strong collaborative abilities, her interdepartmental diplomacy and cooperation, and her ability to have a positive impact on her students' academic achievements. While at Georgia Southern University, Dr. Schriver has been an active member of several influential committees including the University Academic Standards Committee, Advisory Committee to the Provost, and the College of Education's Tenure, Promotion, and Welfare Committee. Additionally, Dr. Schriver published in many professional venues primarily with a focus on science inquiry and pedagogy at the middle level. Her professional memberships have included the Association for the Education of Teachers in Science, the National Science Teacher Association, the Georgia Science Teacher Association, and the National Middle Level Science Teachers Association to name a few. During her tenure, her work was recognized numerous times. She was the recipient of the University's Award for Excellence in Service (2003). In 2006, Dr. Schriver received the College of Education's Jack Miller Educator of the Year Award, an award named for its benefactor and former Dean of the College of Education recognizing a faculty member who excels in teaching, scholarship, and service. In recognition of her many exemplary contributions to the department, college, University, and profession, Dr. Martha Schriver has earned the title of Professor Emeritus of Education.

Dr. David W. Seaman, Professor of French, is retiring May 31, 2016. Dr. Seaman received his Bachelor of Arts degree (1962) from the College of Wooster. He earned both his Master of Arts (1964) and Doctor of Philosophy (1970) degrees from Stanford University. At the time of his retirement, Dr. Seaman will have served Georgia Southern University for 23 distinguished years. Prior to his arrival at Georgia Southern as a professor in 1992, he taught for 27 years at various other institutions of higher education. Additionally, he was a Fulbright Senior Fellow in Morocco (1986-87) and an exchange professor at Central China Normal University. As an instructor, Dr. Seaman is lively and engaging, willing to explore a variety of topics and able to capture students' interests and motivate them to learn course content and to improve in language proficiency. He has taught a wide range of courses in French and also has been active in the University's courses for preparing first-year students. Throughout his tenure, he exhibited a wonderful ability to recruit and retain students in the French program. His accomplishments in scholarship and creative activity are equally notable. He has authored four books, translated four others, and has authored over 40 journal/book articles. He has also published numerous poems and short translations, presented at a lengthy list of conferences, presented on radio programs, and has been featured in a few dozen art shows. His critical and artistic interests have centered principally on the avant-garde movement, and he is widely recognized as an international expert on Lettrisme and Inismo. Over the course of his career, Dr. Seaman has provided extensive service to the department, college, and University as well as served on a variety of national and international scholarly organizations. It is for these numerous distinguished contributions to the department, college, University, and profession that Dr. David W. Seaman is awarded the title of Professor Emeritus of French.

Dr. Charles H. Trupe, III, Associate Professor of Geology, will retire May 31, 2016. Dr. Trupe earned his Bachelor of Science in Geology (1985) from George Mason University. He earned his Master of Science in Geology (1989) and Doctor of Philosophy in Geology (1997) from the University of North Carolina at Chapel Hill. Dr. Trupe taught geology courses at Appalachian State University as a visiting assistant professor before coming to Georgia Southern University in 1998. At the time of his retirement, he will have provided 18 years of distinguished service to Georgia Southern University. As an assistant professor and associate professor of geology, Dr. Trupe taught introductory physical geology and environmental geology courses, and upper-level courses in structural geology, field methods, and tectonics. He was the recipient of the College of Science and Mathematics Excellence in Teaching Award in 2005. Dr. Trupe's research is focused on the structural geology and tectonics of the southern Appalachian Mountains, particularly the segment of the Blue Ridge Mountains along the Tennessee-North Carolina border. His research is field-based and involved many undergraduate research students, of whom most went on to earn graduate degrees in geology after leaving Georgia Southern. Dr. Trupe is active with professional organizations, including the Carolina Geological Society, of which he is a past-president and board member, and the Geological Society of America, serving as Southeastern Section Management Board Chair, member of the Student Support Committee, and member of several organizing committees for annual meetings. During his tenure at Georgia Southern, he served on numerous committees including the College of Science and Mathematics Tenure and Promotion Committee, Faculty Governance Committee, Awards Committee, and Academic Excellence Committee, the College of Science and Mathematics Course and Curriculum Committee, the University Faculty Grievance Committee, and the University Faculty Technology Advisory Committee. Dr. Trupe was appointed the first Associate Chair of the Department of Geology and Geography in 2012, serving until 2016. ACADEMIC DISTINCTION

Graduation with Honors

Undergraduate students, who accomplish a high level of academic achievement, as reflected by their grade point average, receive distinction as follows:

Grade Point Average:

3.5-3.69 *Cum Laude*

3.7-3.89 *Magna Cum Laude*

3.9-4.0 *Summa Cum Laude*

Students graduating with honors are distinguished at commencement exercises by a blue and white honor cord attached to the left shoulder of their gowns. Their distinction is recognized by notation on their diplomas and in their academic transcripts.

NOTE: Since programs are prepared in advance of the receipt of final grades, the listing of candidates and honor recipients may, in some instances, be inaccurate. Also, in addition to GPA, there are other requirements to qualify for graduation with honors. After graduation and all final grades are recorded and all degree requirements are complete, honors are recalculated and will be added to diplomas and transcripts, if honors are achieved.

University Honors Program Scholars

The University Honors Program offers a special Honors curriculum to a select group of academically talented students. In addition to high academic standards, the Program requires a substantial commitment to community service and experiential learning. The diplomas of graduating University Honors Program Scholars are distinguished by the Honors designation.

THE SYMBOLS OF ACADEMIC TRADITION

The Mace

Leading the Processional of faculty and administration is the Macebearer, the Moderator of the Faculty Senate at Georgia Southern University.

The Mace is a two-and-one-half foot shaft and sphere of cast Everdur Bronze and carved American walnut. This representation of the ceremonial symbol of office and authority was designed and crafted in 1988 by Thomas P. Steadman, Associate Professor of Art. Its angular forms and low-gloss finishes are reminiscent of the medieval battle mace from which the more scepter-like academic mace evolved.

The design of the Mace blends forms suggested by native flora of South Georgia. The magnolia leaves and stems encircling the head of the mace in a double helix symbolize Georgia Southern's link with its region. A small ballast rock, found on the Georgia coast and traced to probable British origin, is embedded in the finial base of the shaft representing the foundation of the institution.

The history of academic attire is also traced to the Middle Ages when it may have been necessary for scholars to wear gowns and cowls for warmth in the unheated halls of academe of the period. The robes and hoods have evolved as ceremonial garments signifying level of degree, academic field, and the awarding institution.

Today's gowns for baccalaureate, masters, education specialist, and doctoral degrees are made of a rayon blend, always black. Bachelors gowns have pointed sleeves and are worn closed. The gowns for the masters and specialist degree, also worn closed, have an oblong sleeve with a base that hangs open at the wrist. The doctoral gowns have bell-shaped sleeves which may be worn open or closed. It is the tradition of Georgia Southern to reserve hoods for masters and education specialist degree candidates. These hoods are black, three and one-half feet long, lined with the official colors of the institution, and trimmed in velvet in the color of the degree field.

Caps in the form of mortarboards are made of cotton poplin or a similar material. The tassel is the color which reflects the degree.

The ornamental braided cord draped over the left shoulder of some of the baccalaureate graduates is called a fourragère. The design follows French military tradition and signifies special recognition of baccalaureate students graduating with honors.

Banners

Banners representing each of the eight Colleges and the University Library are displayed at Commencement. Representation of the Banners signifies the colors of disciplines in the Colleges, and celebrates the University's academic programs.

Double Eagle



The Double Eagle Society is an incentive program and a joint initiative between the College of Graduate Studies and the Alumni Association of Georgia Southern. This initiative was created to recognize our alumni who have earned two (or more) degrees from Georgia Southern: one undergraduate degree and one graduate degree or two graduate degrees.

As Georgia's 'large-scale, small-fee' research University, Georgia Southern is known for offering all of the benefits of a major university with the personal feel and individualized attention of a much smaller college. Additionally, with an expanding focus on research, Georgia Southern has created a valuable niche and is attracting a record number of outstanding students from across the state, region and country.

The University also has an active alumni program serving more than 75,000 alumni around the world. Some of the University's prominent alumni include country music star Luke Bryan; Mike Davis, Executive Director of the U.S. Golf Association (USGA); Hala Moddlemog, President of the Metro Atlanta Chamber; and Dan Cathy, President and Chief Operating Officer of Chick-fil-A.

Founded in 1906, Georgia Southern lays claim to being the most beautiful campus in the state. Today, Georgia Southern University acknowledges the remarkable achievements of our graduates and celebrates a popular and enduring commencement tradition with the appearance of Freedom, our American Bald Eagle mascot. Freedom's flight during the singing of the Georgia Southern Alma Mater signifies the conclusion of the commencement ceremony. He serves not only as an ambassador for wildlife, but as an iconic reminder of the strength and majesty of our nation.

Freedom is a male Southern bald eagle that was found knocked out of the nest in Maitland, Florida. Only weeks old and appearing like a “brown ball of fuzz,” it was discovered that the young eagle had an injury to his beak and suffered from an infection. Rushed to the Florida Audubon Center for Birds of Prey, Freedom made a complete recovery from the infection, but the injury to his beak was permanent, preventing his release into the wild. With the permission of the United States Fish and Wildlife Service, Georgia Southern acquired Freedom in 2004.

Through the Georgia Southern University Center for Wildlife Education and Lamar Q Ball, Jr. Raptor Center, thousands of visitors young and old are embraced by the power of Freedom. Freedom is one of three American Bald Eagles housed at the 18-acre sanctuary, located in the heart of Georgia Southern's campus. The Center also contains numerous species of native raptors, reptiles and amphibians.

Did You Know?

- The bald eagle is found only in North America.
- The bald eagle became the official symbol of the United States of America in 1782.
- Georgia Southern University adopted the eagle as its symbol in 1960.
- The bald eagle owes its name to the Middle English term “balled,” meaning “shining white.” The adult bald eagle's head and neck feathers are all white, giving it the name “balled eagle,” meaning “white eagle.”
- The bald eagle has a wingspan of 6-8 ft., and makes its home along coastlines and large bodies of fresh water.
- Eagles are mature at five years of age.
- Eagles require a 25-mile hunting territory and appear to mate for life (can live as long as 50 years).
- Forty years ago, the bald eagle was nearing extinction with just 417 nesting pairs of the birds known in the United States. Today, the bird has made a remarkable comeback and is now off the Endangered Species List.
- In 1983, no nesting pair of eagles could be found in Georgia. Today, Georgia has more than 177 known nesting pairs throughout the state.

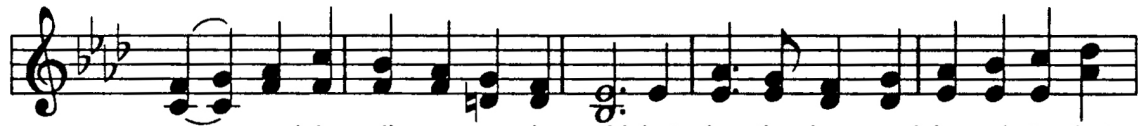

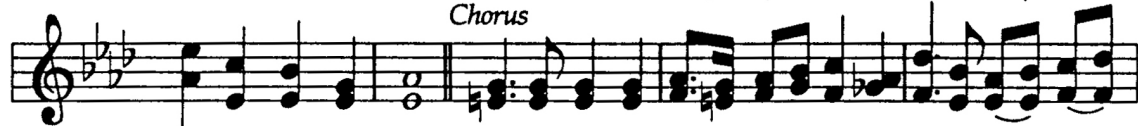
