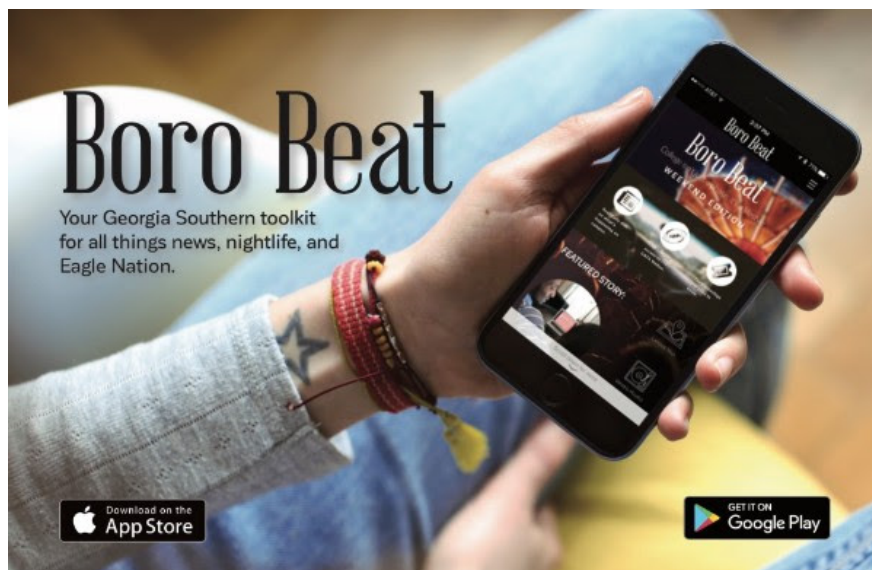
Eagles fall to Redwolves in Jonesboro
