Birmingham, Ala. - Steven Fisk and Archer Price each shot 71, and the Georgia Southern men's golf team fired the third-lowest score of the day to move up another spot and finish fifth at the Shoal Creek Invitational Tuesday at Shoal Creek Country Club.

Fisk (-4) finished sixth, one stroke behind Cameron Young (-5) of Wake Forest in fifth, and five away from Demon Deacon Braden Thornberry (-9), who won medalist honors. Price (-1) finished in a three-way tie for 11th.

Wake Forest (-15) pulled away with a 6-under 282 team score and topped second-place Liberty (-2) by 13 strokes. North Florida (-1) took third, and Ole Miss (E) shot 5-under on its final two holes of the day to squeak past the Eagles (+1) into fourth. Only Wake Forest and North Florida shot lower than Georgia Southern's round of 287.

Barron shot 72, Storey posted a 73 and Alakulppi shot a 77. Individuals Jacob Bayer shot a 77, and Crawford Simmons posted a 79. The Eagles tied Wake Forest for the tournament lead in pars with 171 as a team.

Princeville, Hawaii - Steven Fisk capped a tremendous fall season with a tie for third after carding a 67 in the final round of the Warrior Princeville Makai Invitational Tuesday at Makai Golf Club.

Sparked by yesterday's school and course record 60, Fisk (-18) finished three strokes behind medalist Simon Zach of Louisiana and a shot back of second-place Hayden Buckley of Missouri.

Fisk's 60 in yesterday's second round was just the 13th in college golf history, and he placed in the top-10 in all four events this fall, claiming medalist honors twice and finishing in the top-5 in the last three tournaments.

Luukas Alakulppi shot 69 today, and Jake Storey carded a 75. Archer Price finished with a 76, and Brett Barron posted a 77.

Louisville (-56) won the tournament, besting San Diego State (-47) by nine strokes. Georgia Southern finished 15th.

The field featured eight top-50 squads, according to Golfstat, including the 32nd-ranked Eagles. Ten individuals were ranked in the top-100 in the country, including Fisk, who was ranked ninth.

South Bend, Ind. - Steven Fisk, Archer Price and Brett Barron all shot 67 today to lead the Georgia Southern men's golf team to a second-place finish at the Fighting Irish Classic at Warren Golf Course Monday.

Notre Dame (-18) shot 7-under on the back nine to hold off the hard-charging Eagles (-12), who got to within five strokes of the Fighting Irish at one point.

Fisk tied for first for his second collegiate win and the 11th time the junior has placed in the top-10. Price tied for fourth for the second top-5 finish of his career and his 12th time in the top-20.

Georgia Southern finished the day with a 273, their lowest round since 2005 and two away from the school record of 271, set at the 1980 Gator Invitational. The Eagles shot the second-lowest round of the day to hold off Oakland (-1), which posted an 8-under 272.

Jake Storey shot 72 today and tied for 12th, the 10th top-20 finish of his career. Individual Jacob Bayer posted a 74, and Luukas Alakulppi carded a 76.

The Eagles led the tournament with 56 birdies and led the field in par-4 scoring.

STATESBORO - Georgia Southern senior Jake Storey topped Wilson Furr of Alabama in a 2-hole playoff to win his second straight GS Individual Collegiate at Georgia Southern University Golf Course Monday.

Storey and Furr both parred the par-5 1st, and Storey was off the green following his approach on hole 18, the second playoff hole. The senior chipped to within two feet to make par, while Furr made bogey.

A deluge of rain shortened the event to 36 holes from its scheduled 54. Players were delayed for two hours after nine holes Sunday and came back out to get the first 18 in before coming back for 18 holes today.

Four Eagles finished in the top-20. Storey shot 73-71=144 (E), and Brett Barron shot 75-72=147 (+3) to place seventh. Avery Price posted 72-76=148 (+4) to tie for eighth, and Luukas Alakulppi shot 78-73=151 (+7) to tie for 14th. Archer Price shot 76-78=154, Alexander DeRosa carded 76-79=155, Crawford Simmons shot 81-75=156, Jonas Vaisanen carded 80-78=158 and Jacob Bayer posted 81-82=163.

Duluth, Ga. - Steven Fisk shot a career-low 65 to take medalist honors and lead Georgia Southern men's golf to the team title in the Autotrader Collegiate Classic Tuesday at Berkeley Hills Country Club.

Fisk shot 66-66-65=197 over 54 holes to set the new tournament record and break the Georgia Southern school record by six strokes. Aron Price shot 203 in 2003 and 2005, and Buddy Alexander carded a 203 in the 1975 Schenkel Invitational. Fisk was a stroke better than Braden Thornberry of Ole Miss who posted a 198 to win the Autotrader last year.

Georgia Southern (-17) bested tournament host Georgia State by 24 strokes to claim its first team tournament title since the 2016 Invitational at the Ocean Course. The Eagles' team total of 847 is tied for the eighth-lowest in school history, and GS has finished in the top-6 in eight of its last nine tournaments, dating back to last season.

Fisk finished 19-under for the tournament to win by 12 strokes. It was his third collegiate tournament win and second in a row as the junior tied for first at the Fighting Irish Classic last week. He has 12 top-10 finishes in his career, including all three events this season.

Gainesville, Fla. - Steven Fisk shot a 68, and the Georgia Southern men's golf team solidified a tie for eighth at the SunTrust Gator Invitational Sunday at Mark Bostick Golf Course.

Fisk (-5) tied for sixth, has finished every event this season in the top-10 and has shot under par in 14 of 15 rounds in the campaign. He was three shots behind medalist Hayden Buckley (-8) of Missouri and tied with Dawson Armstrong of Lipscomb.

Jake Storey carded a 73 and tied for 16th, the 13th top-20 of the senior's career.

Vanderbilt (-18) bested the field by five strokes today with a 10-under 270 and won the tournament by nine strokes over host Florida (-9). The Eagles (+7) tied with 14th-ranked Arkansas, a stroke behind 27th-ranked Missouri for seventh and five behind Liberty (+2) in sixth.

Brett Barron shot a 72 today, and Archer Price tallied a 73. Luukas Alakulppi shot 77, and Avery Price, who is playing as an individual this week, carded an 81.

Aiken, S.C. - Archer Price and Jake Storey each shot 69, and the Georgia Southern men's golf team recorded the lowest round of the day with a 286 to move five places up the leaderboard and finish second at the Cleveland Golf Palmetto Intercollegiate Tuesday.

The Eagles' 286 was the lowest round of the day by three strokes, while Storey and Price were the only individuals to shoot under par. It was Georgia Southern's best finish at the Palmetto Intercollegiate.

Statesboro, Ga. - The Georgia Southern men's golf team shot the lowest round for the second straight day Sunday and finished second in the 39th annual Schenkel Invitational at Forest Heights Country Club.

The Eagles shot a 10-under 278 and finished with a team score of 843 (-21), the lowest at the tournament in school history, beating the 2015 team by a stroke.

Vanderbilt (-29), which came into the day with a 12-stroke lead over the host Eagles, shot a 6-under 282 to win the tournament.

Georgia Southern placed second in the tournament for the second straight year and has finished in the top-6 in five of the last six seasons.

Georgia Southern senior Jake Storey (-11) blistered the front 9 with a 30 and finished with a 67 to tie for second with classmate Archer Price, who fired a 69. Storey and Price both finished with a three-round total of 205, the second lowest for an Eagle at the Schenkel. Buddy Alexander posted a 203 (-13) in 1975.

Georgia Southern junior Steven Fisk (-8) shot 68 to tie for seventh.

Jonas Vaisanen (-1) tied for 23rd and Jacob Bayer (+1) tied for 37th.

The Eagles (+19) tied UTA for second in stroke play but will be the third seed in match play because of the fifth-score tiebreaker. GS faces UTA in the semifinals tomorrow morning with the first pairing off the first hole at 8:55 a.m. ET.

Coastal Carolina (-9) finished first in stroke play and will take on fourth-place South Alabama (+22) in the other semifinal match. The winners meet in the afternoon for the championship and the league's automatic bid to the NCAA Championship.

Jake Storey (-1) fired an even-par 71 today and tied for third on the individual leaderboard, and Fisk (+2) finished tied for ninth. Archer Price shot a 73 today, Luukas Alakulppi carded a 76 and Jacob Bayer posted a 77. Coastal Carolina's Morgan Deneen (-10) ran away with medalist honors by following yesterday's 63 with a 67 today.

The Eagles also finished ahead of Georgia State and earn a point in the Southern vs. State Rivalry Series, which State now leads 13.5-3.5.

Kissimmee, Fla. - Steven Fisk of the Georgia Southern men's golf team fired a final-round 74 (2) Wednesday at the Kissimmee Regional of the NCAA Golf Championship, being played at the par-72, 7,154-yard Watson Course at Reunion Resort.

He played as an at-large individual competitor in the field and finished at 6 for the event, concluding his season. Fisk began the day on the 17th hole and proceeded to birdie two of the first three holes he played.

After falling back midway through the round, the junior from Stockbridge, Georgia, finished strong with birdies on two of his final four holes of the season. He finished the day with four birdies and played the back 9 at two-under-par.

The completion of the round marked the end to a fantastic year for Fisk, who became the first GS golfer to earn an at-large individual spot since Bo Fennell in 1991. He was named a semifinalist for the Division I Jack Nicklaus National Player of the Year Award and entered Regionals ranked 22nd by Golfstat. He shot 72 or better in 26 of 33 rounds this season and finished in the top-10 in seven of 10 events, including three top-5s and two wins. He was named to the Haskins Award Watch List and the Ben Hogan Award Watch List and spent a majority of the season ranked in the top-10 for the U.S. Palmer Cup team.

Named Sun Belt Golfer of the Week three times this season, Fisk became the 13th player in college golf history to shoot 60, reaching the mark in the second round of the Warrior Princeville Makai Invitational in October, and he narrowly missed a 16-footer for birdie on his final hole for 59. His 60 was a school and course record, and he followed that round with a 67 to tie for third.
