The university will post more information online and email it directly to graduating students as plans become finalized.

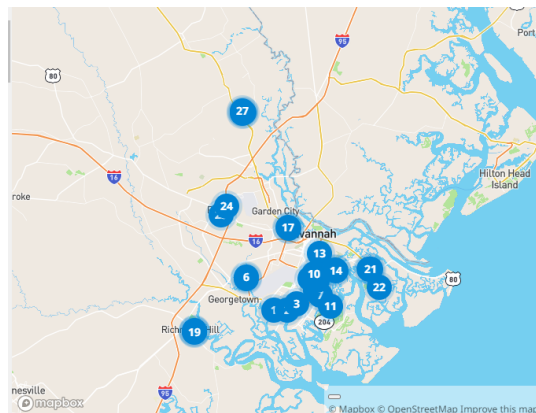
GSU President: Students Have Choices, but Study the Data
