KIAWAH ISLAND, S.C. – Ben Carr shot 33 on the back nine en route to a 73 to lead the Georgia Southern men's golf team in the second round of The Invitational at The Ocean Course Monday.

The third round has been canceled due to Hurricane Florence so the Eagles (+16) finish the tournament tied for fifth with James Madison. Host College of Charleston (+1) topped SMU in a playoff to claim the team title, while Ole Miss (+8) was third and Maryland (+10) took fourth.

Carr finished tied for 17th with teammates Steven Fisk and Avery Price, who both carded a 74 today.

Carr eagled the par-5, 579-yard 16th hole and added birdies on 11 and 12 to play his final eight holes of the day 5-under.

Price played his last six holes 1-under, and Fisk led the Eagles with four birdies on the day.

Individual Mason Williams, who started the round on the back nine, made the turn even and played his final 13 holes of the day even to shoot a 73.

SOUTH BEND, Ind. – Senior Steven Fisk birdied in his final two holes, including a 45-footer on the 18th, to win the Fighting Irish Classic at Warren Golf Course Monday.

It was the third straight victory for Fisk and the sixth of his career. The Eagles (-34) posted 275 as a team to finish second behind 17th-ranked Illinois and three shots clear of North Carolina, which received votes in the latest poll.

Georgia Southern's three-round total of 818 broke the school record of 822 they set last week at The Hummingbird Intercollegiate, and today's round was the fourth time this season the Eagles have shot under 275. The Eagles' team score in each of their last five rounds all rank in the top-15 in school history, including their school record of 266 in yesterday's first round.

Avery Price followed up yesterday's first round of 62 with a 69 today and tied for 10th, and Wilson Address followed his second-round 67 with a 70 today and tied for 17th.

The Eagles ranked second on the par 5s and played them 22-under for the week. GS also played the par 4s 17-under, which ranked second, and posted 64 birdies, which ranked third.

BIRMINGHAM, Ala. – Steven Fisk recorded a pair of 71s to tie for first, and the Georgia Southern men's golf team finished seventh at the Shoal Creek Invitational Tuesday.

Fisk (-6) tied Philip Knowles of North Florida for the fourth win, seventh top-5 and 17th top-10 of his career. Eagles Avery Price and Mason Williams tied for 33rd, while Wilson Address, who played as an individual this week, tied for 17th.

Texas A&M (-8) won the tournament, and North Florida (+1) finished second. Vanderbilt was third, Ole Miss took fourth, and Kansas and Kennesaw State tied for fifth.

Weather suspended play in the second round, and the teams completed the second round this morning and continued right into the third round, making for a long day on the links.

Fisk shot 2-under on his first 10 holes of the second round with birdies at holes 3 and 6 and added a birdie on the 550-yard, par-5 17th to post a 71. The senior opened the third round with 10 straight pars and then made birdie on four of his final seven holes.

DULUTH, Ga. – Steven Fisk and Wilson Address each shot 69, and the Georgia Southern men's golf team held off UNCG by a stroke to win its second-straight AutoTrader Collegiate Classic team title at Berkeley Hills Country Club Tuesday.

Fisk shot 65-65-69=199 (-17) to successfully defend his individual title as well, topping Jonathan Brightwell and Bryce Hendrix of UNCG by five strokes. It was the fourth straight victory of the season for Fisk and the seventh of the senior's career.

It was the second team title of the fall for the Eagles (-35), who shot under par in their last nine rounds. The Eagles' team score in their previous seven rounds all rank in the top-15 in school history.

Address shot 70-68-69=207 (-9) to tie for fourth for the freshman's second top-10 of the campaign, and classmate Ben Carr posted 69-68-71=208 (-8) to tie for seventh, his second top-10 of the season.

The Eagles led the field in par-4 and par-5 scoring and rolled in a tournament high 68 birdies and three eagles.

CASHIERS, N.C. – Freshman Mason Williams shot a 65, senior Steven Fisk posted a 66 and the Georgia Southern men's golf team fired another 272 to pull away from the field and win the The Hummingbird Intercollegiate at the Country Club of Sapphire Valley Tuesday.

GS, which had three freshmen, a sophomore and a senior in the lineup this week, finished with a three-round total of 822 (-30), topping the school record of 828, set at last year's Fighting Irish Classic.

Fisk birdied six holes and shot 29 on the back nine today on his way to his second straight win and fifth career victory, and Williams had a clean card with six birdies and tied for fifth. Freshman Wilson Address shot an even-par 71 and tied for seventh, and classmate Ben Carr shot a 72 and tied for 10th. Sophomore Avery Price posted a 70 and tied for 26th.

The Eagles took advantage of the Par 5s, combining to play them 21-under, and led the tournament in par-3, par-4 and par-5 scoring while rolling in 66 birdies, nine more than Morehead State. Fisk, Williams and Bayer all had 14 birdies, while Address and Carr tallied 13.

Georgia Southern set the tournament record with its three-round total.

Staked by an opening round 66, Duke's Steven DiLisio finished with a three-round total of 208 (-8) to win the tournament by two strokes over Maples, who shot today's lowest round. Nolan Ray (-5) of Tennessee and Jack Parrot (-5) and Andrew Spiegler (-5) of South Carolina rounded out the top-5 and made up the all-tournament team.

The Eagles tied for eighth with Elon, four strokes behind Michigan State and UNCG, which tied for sixth. Tournament host North Carolina, which is ranked 30th in the country, won the event by six strokes over No. 24 Illinois, and Kansas State finished third, a stroke ahead of No. 13 North Florida.

Williams made four birdies on the front nine and shot 34 on the side along with Wilson Andress, who played a clean front nine with birdies at No. 6 and No. 9. Andress shot 73 on the day, while Jake Maples and Brett Barron each carded a 75. Andress tied for 23rd, and Williams tied for 26th.

FRANKLIN, Tenn. – Steven Fisk tied for eighth, and the Georgia Southern men's golf team finished 14th after the final round of the Mason Rudolph Championship Sunday at the Vanderbilt Legends Club South Course.

Brett Barron led the Eagles with a 71 today as the teams had to battle through multiple weather delays to finish the round. Individual Jake Maples shot 68 and tied for 21st on the individual leaderboard. Fisk's tie for eighth was his sixth top-10 finish of the season and 22nd of his career.

Maples made a team best five birdies on the day and shot 2-under on the back nine with birdies and 10, 11 and 18. Barron was even on the back and played his final seven holes of the day 1-under.

The field featured five teams in the top-45, including fourth-ranked Vanderbilt, which hosted the tournament, and 12 individuals in the top-100. Vanderbilt ran away with the team title by 17 strokes over 20th-ranked Liberty.

STATESBORO, Ga. – The Georgia Southern men's golf team fired a tournament-tying, single-round 268 team total in the final round of the 40th Schenkel Invitational Sunday at the Forest Heights Country Club to claim the second team title in the history of the event.

Senior Steven Fisk shot a 7-under 65 for the day with eight birdies against just one bogey to take home medalist honors.

The team win is the second all-time at the Schenkel Invitational, joining the 2014 team in the record books as champions of the event. It's also fifth top-three finish in past six years for the Eagles.

Fisk shot a blistering 14-under 202 to pull away from the field and pick up the eighth of his career, tying Jodie Mudd for most at Georgia Southern. It's also his fifth win this season. He is the fourth Eagle to win the Schenkel and the first since Scott Wolfes in 2014.

Brett Barron posted seven birdies en route to a 65. The total was the second-lowest in his collegiate career and his third-place finish tied his career best.

As a team, the Eagles' 268 tied the Schenkel Invitational record for lowest round, equaling Alabama's 2012 mark shot in the first round.

SANDESTIN, Fla. – Georgia Southern shot a school record 21-under-par 263 as a team Tuesday to win stroke play at the Sun Belt Men's Golf Championship at Raven Golf Club, and Steven Fisk won individual medalist honors for the second time in his career.

GS (-31) topped Coastal Carolina (-27) by four strokes, and Arkansas State (-16) finished third. UTA (-15) and ULM tied for fourth.

Fisk topped Arkansas State's Luka Naglic in a 1-hole playoff to win individual medalist honors. It was the senior's ninth career win, breaking the Georgia Southern record, formerly held by Jodie Mudd.

Fisk, who won the Sun Belt Championship in a playoff in 2017, is the first two-time conference champion in Georgia Southern history and the second player to win the Sun Belt title twice, joining David Fought of Arkansas State, who won it in 1994 and 1997.

Brett Barron made seven birdies with no bogeys to shoot 29 on the back nine, and the junior finished with a 65 to lead the Eagles today. Jake Maples and Ben Carr also shot a 66, giving the Eagles the rare ability not to have to count freshman Colin Bowles' 67. GS made 22 birdies against one bogey on the back nine today.

PALO ALTO, Calif. – For the first time since 2010, the Georgia Southern men's golf team is headed to the NCAA Championship. The Eagles took fourth place at the NCAA Stanford Golf Regional with a -6 three-day total to advance as the No. 10 seed in the regional. Joining Georgia Southern out of the Stanford Regional are No. 12 Stanford, No. 2 Arizona State, No. 26 North Carolina and No. 14 LSU.

While other teams started to drop, the Eagles stayed the course and finished with their third straight 2-under-par 278. Solid scores across the board paved the way for a trip to Fayetteville, Arkansas, next weekend. Senior Steven Fisk and junior Jake Maples led the way on the final day, both carding 68s (-2) as the course showed its teeth late. Freshman Colin Bowles shot even par while Brett Barron and Ben Carr both shot 72s.

The day started with chilly temperatures and light rain scattered around the Palo Alto area. The Eagles started on hole 10 with LSU and Ole Miss and posted seven birdies on their front half. Making the turn, Georgia Southern went -5 on hole one, highlighted by an eagle from Fisk, to kick-start the drive to the finish. As the winds picked up, the conditions toughened and other teams began to fall by the wayside. Three birdies on the seventh hole and a birdie on 8 from Carr all but sealed up the trip to Arkansas.

FAYETTEVILLE, Ark. – Steven Fisk birdied four holes on the back nine and shot a 71 in Monday's fourth round to finish second at the NCAA Men's Golf Championships at The Blessings Golf Club.

Fisk finished 5-under for the tournament and was second to Oklahoma State sophomore Matthew Wolff, who shot 10-under for the tournament. Arizona State's Chun An Yu was third at 3-under. It's the best finish for an Eagle in program history.

On a windy day with gusts up to 29 miles per hour, Fisk made the turn 3-over for the day and in third place, but the senior made a charge on the back, shooting 4-under on the side.

The run started after a perfect layup on the par 5 10th, when he backed up a wedge to within six feet and went on to make birdie. A good drive to the middle of the 11th fairway set him up for an approach into the green that left him four feet to the hole. He rolled it in for consecutive birdies, putting him at 1-over on the day.

After he almost chipped in for birdie on 12, his second shot on the par-5 15th bounced off the green. He came up with another excellent chip and had a tap-in for birdie. Fisk threw a dart into the par-3 17th green that almost went into the cup but rolled onto the fringe behind the green. He made the 15-foot downhill putt going back for his final birdie of the day.

After making par on the first two holes, Fisk had to scramble for a bogey on the par-3 3rd after his tee shot was short and rolled back into the water. His tee shot on 4 found the fairway bunker, and his approach into the wind was also short, rolling back into the hazard. A pitch from the drop zone left him 12 feet downhill to the cup, and his first putt rolled just by the hole, giving him a double bogey.

It was the 13th top-5 finish in his stellar Georgia Southern career, which includes a school record nine victories, and his 25th career top-10. The Eagles got off to a good start as a team and were even-par after five holes as they moved inside the team cut line. Jake Maples' chip in from behind the green for an eagle on 10 had the team 4-over for the round, but GS still had five of the toughest seven holes of the day to get through and fell back to the pack. GS managed to finish ahead of four top-30 teams, according to Golfstat rankings.

GS sees its team season come to a close, but Fisk is the lone senior on the roster playing this week, while two freshmen – Colin Bowles and Ben Carr – gained tremendous NCAA Championship Regional and Finals experience. The Eagles return 10 letterwinners to the 2019-20 roster, and six of those student-athletes saw action in nine or more tournaments this season.
