**KIAWAH ISLAND, S.C.** - Georgia Southern sophomore golfer Scott Wolfes finished with a three-round total of 220 to win the individual title at the Invitational at Kiawah at the Ocean Course, the site of the 2012 PGA Championship.

Wolfes, who began the day as the tournament's leader after shooting a 67 yesterday, labored through a round of 80 and looked to be out of contention with Florida's Tyler McCumber surging past him and into the lead during the final round.

Wolfes, who teed off on hole 10, birdied holes 11 and 15 before double-bogeying 17. He struggled with the first four holes on the front nine, playing them in five-over par before recording a string of four straight pars. He bogeyed hole 9 to finish +4 for the tournament.

McCumber and Florida teammate TJ Vogel teed off on the first hole, and McCumber struggled on the front nine, carding double bogeys at 2 and 4 and bogeys at 3 and 5. Vogel made an early charge, playing the front nine at 1-under, but struggled down the stretch playing the back nine at +5. Both Gators finished a shot back.

**POWELLS POINT, N.C.** - Four Eagles carded under-par rounds as the Georgia Southern golf team shot a combined 11-under total of 277 in the third round to win the Old Dominion Outer Banks Intercollegiate at the Kilmatic Golf Club Tuesday.

It was the second consecutive tournament win for Georgia Southern, the first time the Eagles have done that since 1982, and today's team score ties for the fifth-lowest round in school history.

Scott Wolfes won the individual title after topping Radford's Weston Eklund in a one-hole playoff. The sophomore finished the tournament 9-under, his best three-round total as an Eagle, to win his second individual title this season.

The Eagles went lower each day of the tournament to finish the event with a 10-under par total of 854 as a team. That mark ties for the 14th lowest three-round team score at Georgia Southern.

Charlie Martin finished the tournament in fourth place at 4-under, his second top-5 finish this season. Hayden Anderson tied for 10th, his second straight top-10 finish, with a 217 (+1). Will Evans tied for 27th with a total of 222 (+6).

**NASHVILLE, Tenn.** - Charlie Martin and Scott Wolfes each placed in the top-10, and the Eagles carded a 2-under par round of 282 as a team to charge up the leaderboard and finish fifth at the Mason Rudolph Championship Sunday.

Martin and Wolfes both recorded a 2-under 69, while Anderson shot a 1-under 70.

Martin was steady throughout the round, posting three birdies and one bogey on the day, and the sophomore finished fifth individually, his best career finish, at 4-under par for the tournament.

Wolfes had a chance at a huge day after playing the first 16 holes at 4-under par. After birdies on 14 and 15 and a par on 16, the sophomore bogeyed 17 and 18 for his 69. He tied for eighth at 1-under for the tournament.

Anderson built on yesterday's round of 72 by tearing up the back nine today. After finishing the front nine at 2-over, the junior birdied holes 11, 14 and 18 for a 70.

Henry Mabbett carded a 2-over 73 for the best round of his young career as an Eagle. The redshirt freshman came out of the gates well, got a birdie on the first hole and finished the front nine at 1-over. He played the first eight holes of the back nine at 1-over but slipped on 18 and carded a bogey. Caleb Morris rounded out the group with a 77.

**KAUAI, Hawaii** - Will Evans tied for 13th with a three-round, even-par total of 216, and the Georgia Southern golf team capped its fall season by finishing seventh at the Warrior Wave Invitational at the Makai Golf Club Wednesday.

Hayden Anderson tied for 18th at 1-over par, while Scott Wolfes and Charlie Martin tied for 35th at 6-over.

Baylor won the tournament at 18-under, and NC State (-11) took second. UC Irvine (-6) was third, followed by East Tennessee State (-1), Pepperdine (+3) and Indiana (+5). The Eagles finished with an 870 (+6).

Evans got off to a rough start today with a bogey on his first hole and a double bogey on his second, but the junior rallied by posting birdies on holes 10 and 14 and carding an eagle on 18 en route to a 73. Wolfes had the Eagles' best round of the day with a 71 and birdied four of his last nine holes.

Martin played his first 13 holes at 1-under, but bogeyed four of the last five down the stretch to card a 75. Anderson was 2-over after 16 holes but got a double bogey on his last hole of the day for a 76, and Matt Mierzejewski finished with a 78.

**DULUTH, Ga.** - The Georgia Southern golf team shot a combined 290 in the third round to win the AutoTrader.com Collegiate Classic Tuesday at Berkeley Hills Country Club.

The Eagles, who came into the day with a 12-shot lead over second-place Georgia State, finished 6-over as a team on the day to win the tournament by seven strokes. Georgia Southern was 7-over for the 54-hole tournament.

It was the Eagles' first team tournament title since winning the 2011 Southern Conference Championship, the 11th during head coach Larry Mays' tenure and the 34th in program history.

Mercer was third (+22), and Chattanooga, ranked 54th in the country by Golfweek entering the tournament, took fourth (+29). Winthrop placed fifth (+33), and fifth-ranked Georgia was sixth (+36).

Scott Wolfes shot a 71 today to finish the tournament 1-under and tie for second, his third straight top-10 finish. Hayden Anderson shot a 74 to finish in a tie for sixth at 2-over for the tourney, the best finish of his career.

Will Evans shot a 72 today to place 10th at 5-over par, the best finish of his career, and Charlie Martin shot a 75 to tie for 11th at 6-over. Matt Mierzejewski shot a 73 for the second straight round, the third lowest score of the day for the Eagles.

**GAINESVILLE, Fla.** - Scott Wolfes birdied three holes on his back nine to shoot an even-par 70 and place second at the SunTrust Gator Invitational at the Mark Bostick Golf Course on the campus of the University of Florida Saturday afternoon.

The Georgia Southern golf team fired a 284 to tie for seventh with Liberty (+21). The Eagles were one stroke behind sixth-place Arkansas and two strokes behind fifth-place Central Florida. Florida State won the tournament at 8-under, and North Florida (+7) placed second. South Alabama (+10) was third followed by Florida (+11) in fifth.

Wolfes was 4-under-par for the tournament to record his fourth top-5 finish of the season. The sophomore started on hole 10 today and played his first nine at 2-over. He birdied three of the first seven holes after the turn and bogeyed hole 8 to shoot 70.

Will Evans tied for 20th after posting an even-par 70 today. The junior logged two bogeys on his first nine holes and had two birdies on his second to finish the tournament at 4-over and record his third top-20 finish of the season.

**HILTON HEAD, S.C.** – The Georgia Southern golf team rallied from a three-stroke deficit and posted a 293 in the third round to win the Wexford Plantation Intercollegiate Tournament Tuesday afternoon.

Georgia Southern finished the tournament with a team score of 879 (+15), eight strokes ahead of second-place Francis Marion (+23), which hosted the tournament. Richmond and South Florida (+24) tied for third.

Scott Wolfes finished the second round with a 71 and fired a 70 in the third round to tie for second with a 2-under-par 214, two shots back of Trey Valentine of South Florida. It's the fourth tournament this season in which the sophomore has placed first or second.

Hayden Anderson shot a 72 in round two and a 73 for the final 18 to take fifth with an even-par 216. The junior now has three top-10 finishes and four top-20 outings this season.

Charlie Martin finished his second round with a 71 and posted a 75 in the third round to tie for 11th, his fourth top-15 finish. Blake Olson finished the tournament strong, posting a 76 in the second round and a 75 in the final round. Will Evans carded a 158 in the final two rounds.

**TAMPA, Fla.** – The Georgia Southern golf team posted a 303 in the final round of the Gary Koch Invitational at Old Memorial Golf Club Tuesday afternoon to finish 10th in the 15-team tournament.

The Eagles (+31) were nine strokes ahead of 11th-place Ohio State and UNCG (+40) and six strokes back of South Florida (+25). Florida State (-23) won the tournament and Georgia Tech (-16) placed second. Southern Conference opponent College of Charleston (+11) was sixth.

**HOOVER, Ala.** – The Georgia Southern golf team waited out some rain and grinded through a windy day to shoot a 287 in the final round and take third at the Samford Intercollegiate Tuesday afternoon at Hoover Country Club.

Because frost delayed the start of the tournament Monday, the Eagles had five holes to finish in the second round and posted a 298 this morning before improving that total by 11 strokes in round three. GSU's 287 tied for the second lowest team score in a round for the tournament.

Georgia Southern (+16) was four strokes behind second-place Vanderbilt (+12), while Auburn (+1) won the title after firing a 286 in the final round. Winthrop (+23) placed fourth, and Samford (+24) rounded out the top five.

Will Evans led the way for the Eagles, posting a 70 in the second round and a 72 in the third to tie for fifth, the best finish of his career.

Scott Wolfes was one of three Eagles to fire a 72 in the third round, joining Evans and classmate Charlie Martin, to tie for 14th. Martin tied for 19th, while Hayden Anderson and Blake Olson each tied for 24th. Anderson carded a one-under-par 71 in the final round, and Olson posted a 74.

**CHARLESTON, S.C.** – The Georgia Southern golf team shot a 301 in the third round of the 77th Southern Conference Championships to move up one spot and tie for fifth Tuesday at Ralston Creek Course.

Scott Wolfes was named the league's Golfer of the Year and first-team all-conference. The sophomore won two tournaments, placed first or second in five events and posted seven top-10 finishes. He is the first Eagle to win Golfer of the Year honors since Logan Blondell in 2009.

The Eagles (+45) moved past Elon (+50) and made up two strokes on Appalachian State (+42) but could not pass the Mountaineers, who placed fourth. UNCG made up five strokes on Georgia Southern to tie for fifth, while Elon (+50) and Samford tied for seventh.

Chattanooga (+20), which came into the final round with a 3-shot lead over Davidson, held off the Wildcats (+22) by two strokes. College of Charleston (+34) finished third.

**STATESBORO, Ga.** – Justin Thomas shot a 70, and Bobby Wyatt carded a 71 to lead Alabama to a 285 team score and a second consecutive Schenkel Invitational team title Sunday at Forest Heights Country Club.

Georgia Southern's Scott Wolfes (-4), who played his final three holes of each round a combined 6-under par, posted a 70 to tie for fifth. It's the first top-5 finish for an Eagle at the Schenkel since Logan Blondell placed third in 2008.

GSU went into its final two holes deadlocked with Kentucky and Vanderbilt in a tie for sixth after Hayden Anderson shot 3-under-par on his final four holes, and eagled his last hole of the day to log a 73.

Charlie Martin kept the rally going by birdieing hole 7, one of three birdies on the front nine for the sophomore en route to posting a 73. Wolfes followed by birdieing hole 7 and parring 8 and 9, and the Eagles moved up five spots to finish in a tie for sixth with Kentucky (+19).

Will Evans played the front nine at 1-over and had two birdies and three bogeys on the back nine to log a 74. Blake Olson finished strong again, playing his last nine at 2-over to post a 79.
