ABOUT THE COLLECTION

Biographical: Guthrie "Buddy" Parker Meade enlisted in the United States Navy in 1942 and was assigned to the U.S.S. *Ancon* (AGC-4). During World War II, U.S.S. *Ancon* served in the Mediterranean, participating in the North Africa Occupation, the Sicilian Occupation, and the Salerno landings. In 1944 the U.S.S. *Ancon* served as the flagship for the assault forces that landed on Omaha Beach as part of the Allied invasion of Normandy or D-Day. U.S.S. *Ancon* was later reassigned to the Asiatic-Pacific theater and participated in the assault and occupation of Okinawa. After the war, Meade graduated from Georgia Tech and worked for many years as an engineer. Meade moved to Bulloch County in 1986.

Scope and Content: The collection consists of papers of Guthrie P. Meade from 1942-1993, the bulk of which document his naval service aboard the U.S.S. *Ancon* from 1942-1945. Materials include photographs, printed material, military records, clippings, and journals.

System and Arrangement: This collection is organized by subject matter and then placed in chronological order per folder. The exception to this is oversized material which is organized by order of best fit for the preservation of the materials.
