**SOUTH BEND, Ind.** - Will Evans ran off three straight birdies on the back nine to shoot a 2-under-par 69 in the final round and tie for second at the Fighting Irish Gridiron Golf Classic at Warren Golf Course.

It's the best finish of the senior's career, and his score of 4-under for three rounds is also a career best. It's his third top-10 finish at Georgia Southern.

For the second consecutive round, Evans birdied holes 14, 15 and 16. A bogey on the par-5 17th hole was his only blemish on the back nine, and he had a double bogey on hole 3. He also birdied holes 6 and 8 for his 69.

The Eagles (+16) had a tough day as a team, posting a 293 and falling from second to fourth. Houston (-5) won the tournament and set a tournament record with a score of 847, and Michigan State (+10) placed second. Yale (+15) was third and fellow SoCon member Davidson (+17) finished fifth.

Christian Humber, who played the tournament as an individual, tied for 12th, his best finish at Georgia Southern, after posting a 74 today. Kim Koivu tied for 16th, recording a 72 in all three rounds.

**KIAWAH ISLAND, S.C.** - Georgia Southern sophomore Henry Mabbett carded an even-par 72, and the Eagles shot a team total of 297 to jump ahead two spots and finish fifth at The Invitational at the Ocean Course Tuesday.

South Florida (+7) won the tournament, and South Alabama (+11) placed second. Kentucky (+12) and Georgia tied for third, followed by the Eagles (+33) in fifth. It's GSU's second top-5 team finish of the season, and the tournament featured six teams in Golfweek's top-100 rankings.

Will Evans shot a 76 today to finish 14th (+5) in the individual standings, and Scott Wolfes posted a 73 to tie for 17th (+7). Georgia's Joey Garber followed his 66 yesterday with a 68 today to win individual medalist honors, and teammate Lee McCoy fired a tournament record 65 to move from 23rd into a tie for fifth.

Mabbett's 72 was the lowest in his career as an Eagle. Hayden Anderson posted a 76, Drew Guffey, who played as an individual, carded a 79 and Kim Koivu shot an 82.

**BIRMINGHAM, Ala.** - Will Evans shot a 1-over-par 73 in the final round and tied for third at the Shoal Creek Intercollegiate Tuesday. Georgia Southern placed seventh in the 12-team tournament, which featured seven teams in the top-50 in the country.

Evans bogeyed his first and last holes of the day, but those were the only blemishes on his card. The senior birdied the par-3 13th hole and collected 15 pars on the way to his second top-3 finish of the young season after shooting 68-69-73=210. He tied for second at the Fighting Irish Gridiron Classic last weekend.

Scott Wolfes carded a 74, while Kim Koivu and Charlie Martin each posted a 78. Christian Humber shot a 79, and Sam Towler, seeing his first collegiate action as an individual, shot a 79.

The Eagles (+11) fell one spot to seventh with today's 303 team score. Memphis fired a 12-under-par 276 to move up the board into first at 22-under for the tournament. **JACKSONVILLE, Fla.** - Scott Wolfes backed up his second-round 70 with a 1-under-par 71 to lead the Georgia Southern golf team to a team score of 298 and a sixth-place finish at the Eagle/Osprey Intercollegiate at Deerwood Country Club Tuesday afternoon.

It was another windy and rainy day on the course. Wolfes' third-round total was the third-lowest of the day and one of six under par, as the junior tied for second, his best finish of the season.

After shooting a 39 on the front nine, Wolfes posted four birdies and five pars on the back and birdied 18 to finish with an even-par three-round total of 216.

Charlie Martin carded a 74 for a total of 224 (+8) and tied for 20th, while Christian Humber shot a 73 for a 225 (+9) to tie for 23rd. Will Evans and Hayden Anderson each shot an 80 today.

**DULUTH, Ga.** - The Georgia Southern golf team fired a 2-under-par 286 and finished under par for the first time this season as the Eagles tied for seventh with Virginia Commonwealth in the AutoTrader Collegiate Classic at Berkley Hills Country Club Tuesday.

Host Georgia State (-19) won the tournament, and South Florida (-17) placed second. South Alabama (-15) took third, followed by Chattanooga (-9), Kentucky (-8) and Mercer (-5). Georgia Southern finished 3-under for the tournament. Kentucky was the big mover today as the Wildcats fired a tournament low 275 and jumped from 10th to fifth.

Sparked by a 67 in the second round, Scott Wolfes was the Eagles' top individual as the junior posted a 73 today and tied for eighth.

Will Evans posted a 71 today to tie for 25th, and Christian Humber carded a 70 to tie for 30th. Kim Koivu shot a 72, and Charlie Martin logged a 75.

The Eagles took full advantage of the par-5 15th hole, the easiest hole on the course for all three rounds, as the quintet combined to play it at 7-under this afternoon. Humber and Wolfes logged eagles, while Evans, Koivu and Martin notched birdies.

**GAINESVILLE, Fla.** - Scott Wolfes fired a 3-under-par 67 in the final round of the SunTrust Gator Invitational at the Mark Bostick Golf Club Sunday, and the Eagles tied for seventh in their first tournament of the spring.

The lone blemish on Wolfes' card was a bogey on the first hole. The junior birdied hole 7 to finish the front nine even par and birdied the first three holes after the turn. He finished the day with six straight pars to move up from 15th into a tie for sixth in the individual standings.

Georgia Southern (+34) fell two spots into a tie for seventh with Liberty, six shots behind Mercer (+28) and UAB, which tied for fifth. The field of 14 featured eight teams in the top-50, according to the GolfStat rankings.

Will Evans shot a 73 to tie for 30th. The senior struggled on the front nine, playing it 3-over, and was even-par on the back with two bogeys and two birdies.

**BIRMINGHAM, Ala.** - Charlie Martin matched his career low with a 68 in the final round to tie for fifth at the Samford Intercollegiate Tuesday at Hoover Country Club. The Georgia Southern golf team moved five spots after the first round to finish sixth in the 16-team field.

South Alabama (+27) shot a 291 in the last round to move ahead of UAB (+29). Campbell was third (+42) followed by Belmont (+48) and Jacksonville State (+49). The Eagles (+50) posted a 304 in the second round and a 291 in the third.

**FRANKLIN, Tenn.** - Charlie Martin shot a 73 to garner fourth place, matching his best career finish, and Georgia Southern posted a team total of 285 to finish fifth in the final round of the Mason Rudolph Championship at Vanderbilt Legends South Course Sunday.

The Eagles' total today was the sixth-lowest round of the weekend, and they finished 16-over-par for the tournament, three back of Mercer (+13) and Louisville. Alabama (-5), ranked first in the country, posted a 12-under-par 272 today to run away with the title, and Vanderbilt (+4) finished second in its home event, which featured six top-50 teams.

Martin finished with a 2-under-par 211 for the tournament to lead the Eagles, and Scott Wolfes shot a 3-under-par 68 today to move from 26th into a tie for 12th. Hayden Anderson posted an even-par 71 to tie for 29th, while Henry Mabbett shot a 73 to tie for 39th. Will Evans posted an 81 today.

Martin was 4-over through his first 15 holes before birdieing 16 and 18 to finish the round and solidify his fourth career top-5 finish, matching a fourth-place outing at the ODU/OBX Intercollegiate in the fall of 2012.

**STATESBORO, Ga.** - The 2014 Eagles etched their name into the annals of Georgia Southern golf by winning the Schenkel Invitational team title at a rain-soaked Forest Heights Country Club Sunday. It is the first time the Eagles have won their home tournament, one of the most prestigious in college golf, which featured four top-20 teams this year.

Junior Scott Wolfes won the individual medalist honors after firing a 68 and finished the tournament 7-under par (71-70-68=209). He is just the third Eagle to take home the individual title, joining Jimmy Ellis in 1973 and Richie Bryant in 1989.

Anderson and Evans provided the magic Saturday with each aing a par-3 hole to stake the Eagles to a four-shot lead after the second round. Wolfes and Charlie Martin, who shot a 72 today, helped increase the margin as Georgia Southern (-14) finished eight strokes ahead of UAB (-6).

Four Eagles finished in the top-6 of the individual standings and five were in the top-25. Evans posted a 73 today to finish 3-under for the tournament and tie for fourth, and Henry Mabbett, who played as an individual, shot 71 to tie for fourth. Martin tied for sixth, and Anderson tied for 22nd.

**PINEHURST, N.C.** - Hayden Anderson aced the par-3 ninth hole with a 5-iron to spark a Georgia Southern run, and the Eagles held off Chattanooga by a stroke to claim the Southern Conference Men's Golf Championship Tuesday at National Golf Club.

It was Anderson's second hole-in-one this season, and the Eagles, who competed in the SoCon Championship for the final time, won their fourth title in school history.

The Eagles were 1-over on the day and had a four-shot lead heading into the final hole, but Georgia Southern played the par-4 18th hole 4-over, leaving the door open for Chattanooga. The Mocs' Chris Robb, who was 7-under on the day, had a 25-foot birdie putt to tie and force a playoff, but the ball just squeaked over the right edge, giving the Eagles (+9) the 1-stroke victory.

Charlie Martin posted nine birdies and shot a 1-under 71 to lead the Eagles, and Anderson finished with a 73. Henry Mabbett carded a 74, and Will Evans notched a 75. Scott Wolfes, who started the day 6-over after four holes, grinded his way to a 76.

Martin (E) placed fourth for the Eagles, Evans (+2) tied for sixth and Wolfes (+3) tied for ninth after shooting a 66 Monday.

**LAKE WORTH, Fla.** - Scott Wolfes fired a four-under-par 67, and Georgia Southern tallied a 282 to finish second in the FAU Slomin Center Invitational at The Fountains North Course.

Central Florida (-13), which is ranked sixth in the country, won the tournament, and the Eagles (-7) were the only other team under par. Middle Tennessee State (+2) was third, followed by DePaul (+11) and Jacksonville State (+19).

Hayden Anderson shot a 70 for the Eagles today, and Will Evans notched a 71. Henry Mabbett carded a 74, and Charlie Martin finished with a 75.

Wolfes (-4) tied for fourth in the individual standings, and Anderson (-3) placed sixth. Evans (-1) tied for seventh, and Martin (+2) tied for 12th. Mabbett (+6) tied for 19th.

Wolfes posted a clean card with four birdies. The junior birdied his first two holes and birdied holes 11 and 14. Anderson also birdied his first two holes and made the turn at 2-under. The senior bogeyed 13, birdied 15 and bogeyed 16.

Evans birdied the first hole and then ran off eight straight pars. The senior bogeyed hole 10, birdied 11 and bogeyed hole 15. Martin double bogeyed the first hole before notching nine straight pars. He bogeyed holes 11 and 17 for his 75.

Mabbett birdied the second and sixth holes but was hurt by a double bogey on hole 3. He was 1-over at the turn and had two bogeys on the back for his 74.

**SAN ANTONIO, Texas** - Junior Scott Wolfes fired a team-leading 73, but Georgia Southern saw its season come to a close at the NCAA Men's Golf Championships San Antonio Regional Saturday at Briggs Ranch Golf Club.

Sent off hole 10, the easier side all week for Georgia Southern, which finished the tournament 16-over, the Eagles just could not get anything going early and made the turn to the tougher side at 4-over. They ended the day with a team score of 302, dropping them from a tie for fifth to eighth and out of contention for a bid to the finals.

Senior Hayden Anderson finished with a 77 today and tied for 21st in the individual standings with classmate and roommate Will Evans, who shot 75. After his 68 helped put the Eagles in the mix yesterday, Charlie Martin posted a 77 today and tied for 25th, while Matthew Mierzejewski finished with an 81.

The round turned out to be the last in college for Anderson and Evans, and it's fitting the 4-year players tied in their final outing. Anderson played in three NCAA Regionals and was in the lineup for two Southern Conference Championship titles. Evans played in two NCAA Regionals and helped key the Eagles' SoCon title in April, tying for sixth at 2-over for the tournament.
