Title (2.3): Arntzen Photographs of Armstrong

Date(s) (2.4): 2004-2017.

Extent (2.5): 2.8 TB of digital photo files, over 400,000 files, most in jpg format. Housed on an external hard drive called “kat’s backup” formatted for MAC.

Name of Creator(s) (2.6): Katherine Arntzen, Photographer in Dept of Marketing and Communications department on Armstrong campus.

Scope and Content (3.1): Campus photographer’s photograph files. Photos document most aspects of the Armstrong campus during this era, when Armstrong was called Armstrong Atlantic State University (AASU) and Armstrong State University. Included are events (graduation, campus visits, groundbreakings, etc.), athletics, campus facilities, many campus activities and candid and posed photographs of students, many to illustrate campus promotional materials. Also a portrait collection arranged by name, mostly of faculty and staff. An extensive collection it seems that most photos Arntzen took were archived here.

Conditions Governing Access (4.1): Unrestricted

Language and Scripts of Material (4.5): English

Administrative/Biographical History (2.7): Armstrong’s Marketing and Communications (before 2009 University Relations) department was responsible for major campus publications, such as *The Compass*, then *Armstrong* magazine, recruiting materials, advertising and publicity for the University. In 2009 the department added responsibility for the design of the University’s website. Starting in 2005 Katherine Arntzen served as principle photographer for the department and also did photography at the request of other departments and faculty members on campus.

Arrangement:

Photos are divided into two folders:

A. AASU Portraits

AASU Portraits folder is divided by last name of the subject, e.g. bleicken_linda, as either the file name or, if several files, the folder name. Many of the folders included multiple versions of the portrait and multiple file versions .NEF (Nikon

raw image) and .xmp Sidecar, as well as jpg versions. Size: 70 GB and 15, 303 items.

B. AASU Photo Archive

AASU Photo Archive is mainly divide by year, folders for 2004-2017. Plus a folder labeled *Various images frequently requested* and another called *Textures*. Size of this folder: 2.8 TB and 408,001 items.

The folders for each year, 2004-2017, are subdivided mainly by week and then by event/shoot, with a brief description and date. the folder labels are less clear for 2004 and 2005 folders subdivisions but the arranged still basically by week with the folder titles CD 1, 2, etc. In 2016-2017 folders are first subdivided by month, then by week.
