**KIAWAH ISLAND, S.C.** - Matt Mierzejewski led the Georgia Southern men's golf team with an even-par 72 Sunday, and the Eagles posted a 297 to open their season with a third-place finish of 14 teams at the Invitational at The Ocean Course.

South Florida (-14) ran away with the team title after shooting a 4-under 284 today. Georgia State (+13) jumped in front of the Eagles (+15) by two strokes, and Troy (+18) came in fourth. Kentucky (+19) rounded out the top-5.

Scott Wolfes (-5) shot a 74 today and tied for third, the 11th top-5 finish of his career. Charlie Martin posted a 76 and tied for 14th, the 15th top-20 outing of his career.

Henry Mabbett carded a 75, and Sam Towler finished with an 80. Andrew Klasing, playing as an individual this week, shot a team-low 71.

Chase Koepka (-8) of South Florida took home medalist honors, followed by Bright Julamool (-7) of Western Carolina. Wolfes tied Troy's Jared Bettcher (-5) and Western Carolina's J.T. Poston (-5).

**KIAWAH, S.C.** - Georgia Southern senior Scott Wolfes shot a Turtle Point Golf Course record 63 in the final round to win co-medalist honors, and Georgia Southern carded a team score of 278 and took second at the Wendy's Kiawah Classic.

Wolfes' score topped the old mark of 65, set by Georgia Southern alum Aron Price at the 2003 Kiawah Intercollegiate, and is also tied for the lowest in Georgia Southern history with Spence Fulford, Travis Mobley, Richie Bryant and Fred Benton.

Georgia Southern's team score was the lowest round of the tournament, and the Eagles (+4) had the low round for the second straight day. Georgia Southern finished four strokes behind tournament winner Winthrop (E) in a field of 20 teams.

Whereas the Eagles struggled coming in on the first two days, they played their last five holes at 8-under-par today.

Wolfes (-6) turned in a clean card with nine birdies, including five in a row at one point, and six total on the back nine. It was his fourth individual collegiate win, his 12th top-5 finish and his 19th time in the top-10. He tied Ryan Cornfield of USC Upstate for first place.

Archer Price (-3) shot a 1-under 71, including birdies on his final two holes, to tie for 5th. The freshman was a stroke behind Winthrop's Zach Seabolt (-4), who placed fourth, and two back of Jacksonville State's Tomasz Anderson (-5), who took third.

Matt Mierzejewski shot a 69, and Kim Koivu posted a 75. Charlie Martin finished with a 78.

**BIRMINGHAM, Ala.** - The Georgia Southern men's golf team fired a team total of 295, the third-lowest score in today's final round, to finish sixth at the Shoal Creek Invitational Tuesday at Shoal Creek Country Club.

North Florida (-5) carded a 287 to overtake two-time defending national champion Alabama (-2), which finished second. Tournament host UAB (E) placed third followed by Ole Miss (+14), Memphis (+15) and Georgia Southern (+16). Southeastern Louisiana (+20) was seventh, and Central Florida (+22) took eighth.

The Eagles had a chance to finish in the top-5 but were hurt by their final hole of the day, the 462-yard, par-4 9th hole. Scott Wolfes hit his tee shot in the rough and flew his second shot into a greenside bunker with a tough shot coming out towards the water. His bunker shot wound up in the water, and when it was all said and done, the senior had to run in a 5-footer to make a triple bogey.

Henry Mabbett and Matt Mierzejewski each had their-second best finishes in collegiate competition. Mabbett shot a 72 to tie for 14th, and Mierzejewski carded a 73 to tie for 17th. Wolfes shot a 76 and tied for 10th for the 17th top-10 finish of his career, and Charlie Martin carded a 74 and tied for 31st.

Archer Price posted a 76 and tied for 40th in his first collegiate tournament, and Kim Koivu, who played as an individual this week, shot 77 and tied for 38th.

**GAINESVILLE, Fla.** - Charlie Martin carded a 2-under-par 68, and Georgia Southern fired the second-lowest team total of the day, an even-par 280 to finish fifth at the SunTrust Gator Invitational at Mark Bostick Golf Course Sunday.

Georgia Southern (+27), which came into the event ranked 50th in the Golfstat team rankings, placed ahead of No. 6 Vanderbilt (6th, +29), No. 28 North Florida (7th, +34) and No. 34 UAB (10th, +43). It was the Eagles' best finish at the Gator Invitational since placing fifth in 2006-07.

Martin's lowest round of the season shot him 17 spots up the individual leaderboard to tie for 15th. Scott Wolfes and Kim Koivu each carded even-par 70 to tie for 23rd. Archer Price posted a 72 today, and Matt Mierzejewski shot a 75.

**RALEIGH, N.C.** - Matt Mierzejewski, Charlie Martin and Kim Koivu all shot under par, and the Georgia Southern golf team carded a 282 in the final round to finish in a tie for fourth at the Wolfpack Intercollegiate at Lonnie Poole Golf Course Tuesday.

Mierzejewski shot 2-under on the back nine to finish with a 69, and Martin had three birdies on the back nine to post a 1-under-par 70. Koivu capped his round with 12 straight pars to card a 70, while Scott Wolfes shot a 73 and Henry Mabbett notched a 74.

Georgia Southern's team total was the second-lowest of the day and lowest of the season for the Eagles (+16), who moved from sixth into a tie with UNCG for fourth. Host NC State (-6) won the tournament, East Tennessee State (+3) placed second and East Carolina (+11) was third.

Wolfes (-1) tied for sixth for his third straight top-10 finish and the 18th of his career. Mierzejewski (+3) tied for 15th, his second consecutive top-20 finish, and Koivu (+7) tied for 27th.

**HILTON HEAD, S.C.** - Scott Wolfes and Kim Koivu tied for third, and the Georgia Southern men's golf team tied for second after finishing the second round of the Wexford Intercollegiate at Wexford Plantation Golf Course Tuesday.

The teams were slated to play 36 holes Monday, but play was suspended with 6-7 holes left because of darkness. The second round was completed today, but the third round was canceled due to inclement weather, leaving the tournament at 36 holes.

Wolfes posted a 75 in the second round to finish with a 144 (E), and Koivu shot a 1-under 71 in the second round for a 144 (E). The duo tied with three other players.

**AIKEN, S.C.** – Georgia Southern's Scott Wolfes shot an even-par 70 today to finish 8-under for the tournament and tie for second in the Cleveland Golf Palmetto Invitational at Palmetto Golf Club.

The senior was one stroke shy of South Carolina's Will Starke (-9) and tied Cody Proveaux of Clemson. The tournament featured five teams in the top-50 in the country and 17 individuals in the top-100.

Wolfes started on hole 7 today, and birdies on holes 14 and 18 moved him to 10-under for the tournament with four holes to go. He bogeyed holes 3 and 4 and finished with consecutive pars to post even-par for the day. It's the 14th top-5 and 21st top-10 finish of his career.

Archer Price shot a 72, Jake Storey fired a 73, Charlie Martin posted a 78, and Kim Koivu finished with a 79 today as the Eagles placed eighth in the team standings (+17), a stroke ahead of Wofford (+18) and Maryland South Carolina (-15) won the tournament, followed by Clemson (-14).

Price started on hole 9 today and birdied three of his first six holes to make the turn to the front 9 at even par. The freshman parred seven of his last eight holes, but a double bogey on hole 3 left him with a 2-over 72.

Storey began on hole 8 and was 1-under with six holes to go after birdies on holes 10 and 14. The freshman posted three straight pars after consecutive bogeys but finished with a 73 after a double bogey on hole 7.

**DESTIN, Fla.** – Senior Kim Koivu shot 71 in the final round of the Sun Belt Conference men's golf championships to take medalist honors Tuesday at Raven Golf Club, and Georgia Southern won the team title in its inaugural season in the league.

It was the Eagles' second consecutive conference championship - Georgia Southern won the Southern Conference last season - and the ninth conference title in school history. The victory gives Georgia Southern the Sun Belt's automatic bid to the NCAA Regionals May 13-15. The Eagles will find out their destination and competition during the NCAA Championship Selection Show May 4.

Koivu (-6) held off classmate Scott Wolfes (-4) who shot 72 today to finish second. Freshman Archer Price (+6) carded a 74 today and tied for 21st, while junior Andrew Klasing (+4) posted a 78 and tied for 12th. Senior Matt Mierzejewski (+10) shot a 79 and tied for 32nd.

The Eagles (-3) were the only team to shoot under par for the tournament and won by 16 strokes over second-place UT Arlington (+13). ULM (+14) shot an even-par 284 today to move to third, and Georgia State (+15) finished fourth.

Koivu became the eighth Eagle to win a conference individual title and the first since Drew Lethem, who won the SoCon in 2009. His score of 69-67-71=207 tied for the fourth-lowest round in Sun Belt championship history and was the lowest since 2008.

Georgia Southern's team score of 279-275-295=849 was just three strokes higher than the Sun Belt Championship record of 846, set by South Alabama in 1994.

**STATESBORO, Ga.** – Auburn posted a 19-under 269 in the second round and withstood a late rally by Vanderbilt to take home the 2015 Schenkel Invitational team title after a 36-hole day at Forest Heights Country Club Saturday.

Auburn surged ahead of Vanderbilt (-41) by shooting 19-under-par in the second round, which ties for the second-lowest round in Schenkel Invitational history. The Commodores (-40) returned the favor with a 269 on the final 18 holes, leaving them one shy of a tie for first. Alabama fired a 269 in the second round in 2012 after posting a 268 in the first round en route to running away with the team title.

Auburn's Daniel Stringfellow shot 65-69 today to take home medalist honors at 12-under par.

Georgia Southern (-20) posted a 278, the third-lowest score of the second round, to move into third and followed that with a third round total of 284 (-4) to stay ahead of surging Kentucky (-18). Wake Forest and NC State (-17) tied for fifth.

The tournament featured 11 top-50 teams in the country, according to Golfstat, and 12 individuals ranked in the top-100.

Three Eagles finished in the top-25 with Kim Koivu (-7) leading the way after carding 70-69 today and tying for 12th. The Eagles three-round total of 844 was their best at the Schenkel in school history and six strokes better than last season's 850, which brought them their first Schenkel title in the 36-year history of the tournament.

Illinois (-4) and SMU shared first place, and UNLV (-1) took third. UCLA (+5) and Oregon (+7) rounded out the top-5. Colorado's David Orace (-7) earned the individual advancing spot, and Brian Campbell (-10) of Illinois took medalist honors.

Kim Koivu shot 77 today and tied for 43rd, while Archer Price shot 77 and tied for 51st. Matt Mierzejewski carded a 79, and Andrew Klasing posted an 86.

Wolfes earned Golfer of the Year honors in two different leagues and was a four-time all-conference selection.
