Betty Foy Sanders Department of Art Announces \$500,000 Gift From Gov. Carl Sanders' Estate



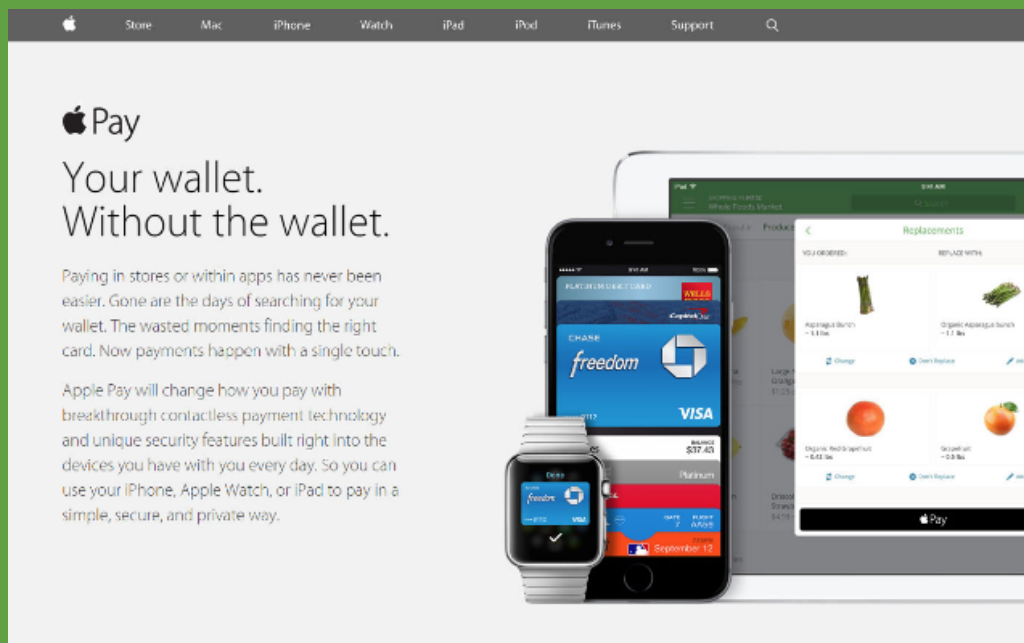
