In addition to our recent announcements about [The George-Anne](#) and the [new GIL-Find catalog](#), the library is excited to announce the following resource updates for Fall 2017:

Credo Reference Academic Core Collection

As part of our approaching consolidation with Armstrong, the library now subscribes to the Credo Academic Core collection. This collection includes over 650 titles with emphasis on subject encyclopedias, dictionaries, atlases, and reference handbooks. These titles enhance our existing Credo title list.

Ebook Central

Library is now [EBook Central](#), which is available on and off-campus via the Library's [A-Z Database List](#), [GIL-Find](#), and [Discover](#). Ebook Central offers authoritative ebooks in a wide range of subject areas, along with powerful tools to help you find, use, and manage the information you need. Ebook Central includes the following ebook collections:

- **Academic Complete** is a growing, multidisciplinary collection of over 125,000 scholarly ebooks.
- **College Complete** ebook subscription database contains more than 40,000 titles.
- **Public Library Complete** ebook subscription database with more than 35,000 titles.

Georgia Historic Newspapers Archive

The Digital Library of Georgia (DLG) recently launched the new [Georgia Historic Newspapers Archive](#), which features historic newspaper titles from around the state. This archive is now available via the Library's [A-Z Database List](#), [GIL-Find](#), and [Discover](#).

Since 2007, the Digital Library of Georgia has been providing access to the state's historic newspapers through multiple, online city and regional newspaper archives. The DLG's newest website, [Georgia Historic Newspapers Archive](#), continues that tradition by bringing together new and existing resources into a single, consolidated website.

The [Georgia Historic Newspapers Archive](#) includes some of the state's earliest newspapers; important African-American, Roman Catholic, and Cherokee newspapers; and issues from Augusta, Atlanta, Columbus, Fayetteville, Houston county, Louisville, Thomson, Sandersville, Waycross, and Waynesboro. The latest additions bring the total number of newspaper pages available free online through the DLG to 825,000 pages.

Like the older DLG newspaper sites, the [Georgia Historic Newspapers Archive](#) provides newspaper issues that are full-text searchable and can be browsed by date and title.

Nexis Uni

LexisNexis Academic is now [Nexis Uni](#), which is available on and off-campus via the library's [A-Z Database List](#), [GIL-Find](#), and [Discover](#).

Nexis Uni contains thousands of publications, virtually all include full text. Many types of publications are included: newspapers (in English, other languages, and translations of international papers), legal news, general interest magazines, medical journals, trade publications, company financial information, transcripts, wire service reports, government publications (such as the federal case law, U.S. Code, Code of Federal Regulations, Congressional Testimony, etc.), law reviews, and reference works (such as the Forbes Annual Directory, the Official Guide/American Marketplace and the US Global Trade Outlook).

Nexis Uni will completely replace LexisNexis Academic later this fall, at which time all links to LexisNexis Academic will be removed from the library website and LibGuides. Additionally, all links to filtered LexisNexis Academic searches that currently appear on the Library A-Z Database List will be updated to Nexis Uni later this fall.

TumbleBookCloud

[TumbleBookCloud](#) is now available to the Georgia Southern community via the Library's [A-Z Database List](#), [GIL-Find](#), and [Discover](#).

[TumbleBookCloud](#) is an online collection of ebooks, enhanced novels, graphic novels, videos and audio books, which offers students and adults of all reading levels access to a wide range of content. TumbleBookCloud includes a large collection of YA titles and graphic novels. Access to [TumbleBookCloud](#) is provided by GALILEO.
