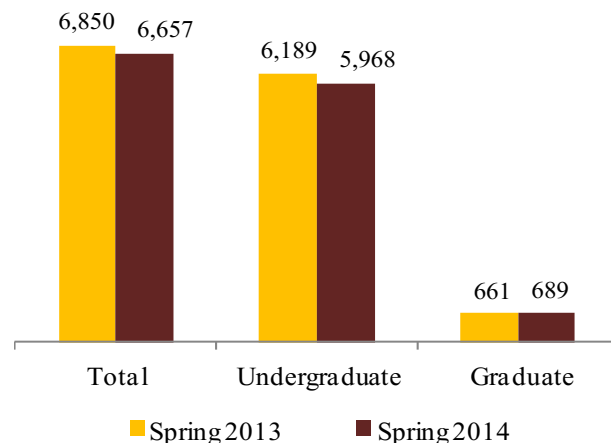

Graduate FTE is determined by counting each full-time student as 1 (where full-time is defined as enrolled for 9 or more hours) and adding the remaining credit hours for graduates divided by 9.
