Kind of a big Deal

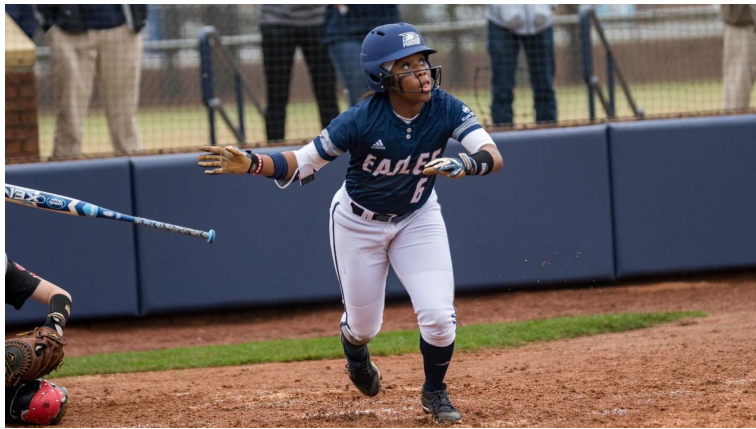
