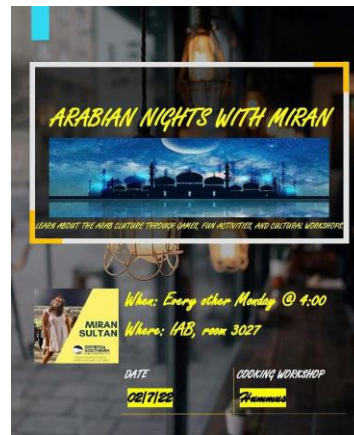
CLUB EVENTS
