The Department of Music's month-long celebration of the voice begins Sunday, September 15, with a recital by the Department's Statesboro-based Vocal Arts faculty. The recital features performances by faculty members Marquese Carter, Arikka Gregory, Sarah Hancock, Allen Henderson, Jonathan Murphy, Briana Sosenheimer, and our very special guest, Jane Redding Marrero, with assistance at the piano by collaborative artists Ken Chan, Jonathan Murphy, and Karla Rocker.

The concert is free and open to the public, and begins at 5:00 pm (note the start time) in the Carol A. Carter Recital Hall on Georgia Southern's Statesboro Campus.

The celebration continues Saturday, October 5 with the annual Vocal Arts Gala, featuring Southern Chorale, University Singers, Southern Gentlemen, Southern Sirens, as well as specially-selected student soloists, and concludes with Georgia Southern Opera's performances of Claudio Monteverdi's masterpiece, *L'Orfeo*, October 18 and 19 in the Carol A.
