SoTL Award

The Georgia Southern University SoTL Award recognizes faculty for their outstanding contributions to the Scholarship of Teaching and Learning (SoTL). All full-time faculty members who have held a teaching position at Georgia Southern University for a minimum of two years may apply for the award. *Previous award recipients are not eligible to apply for four years after receiving the award.*

SoTL Fellowship

The fellowship supports up to two faculty each year in their advancement and completion of quality, innovative SoTL research projects that improve the understanding of teaching and learning. Full-time faculty members may apply for the fellowship. For collaborative SoTL projects, only one application may be submitted (usually for the primary investigator of a project). *Previous fellowship recipients are not eligible to apply for four years after receiving the award.*
