Ed Jones with his never ending smile, and my boss, Richard Mandes, could always see the end.

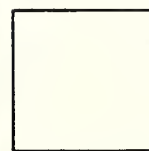
Those who kept my spirits up and in a quiet way gave me more than they can know—Hoyt, Bea, Jackie, Frances, and Sallie.
