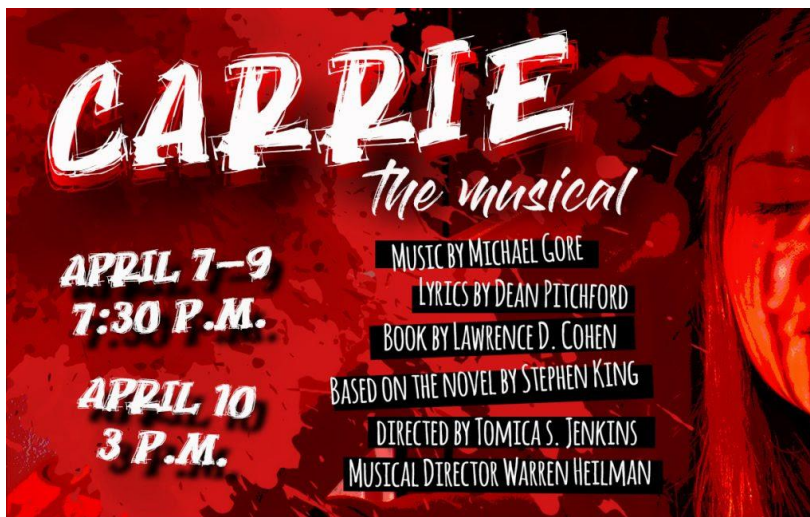
Student Spotlight: Sarah Lee
