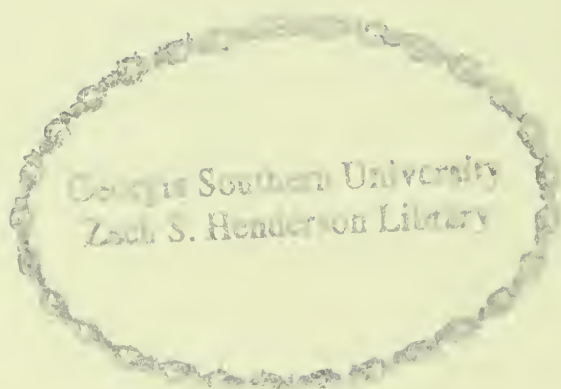

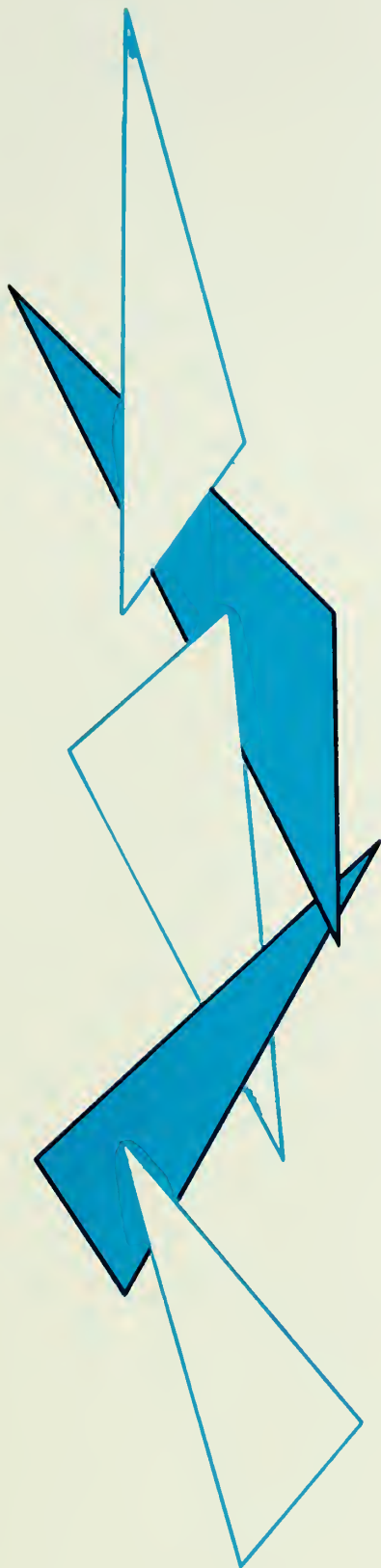

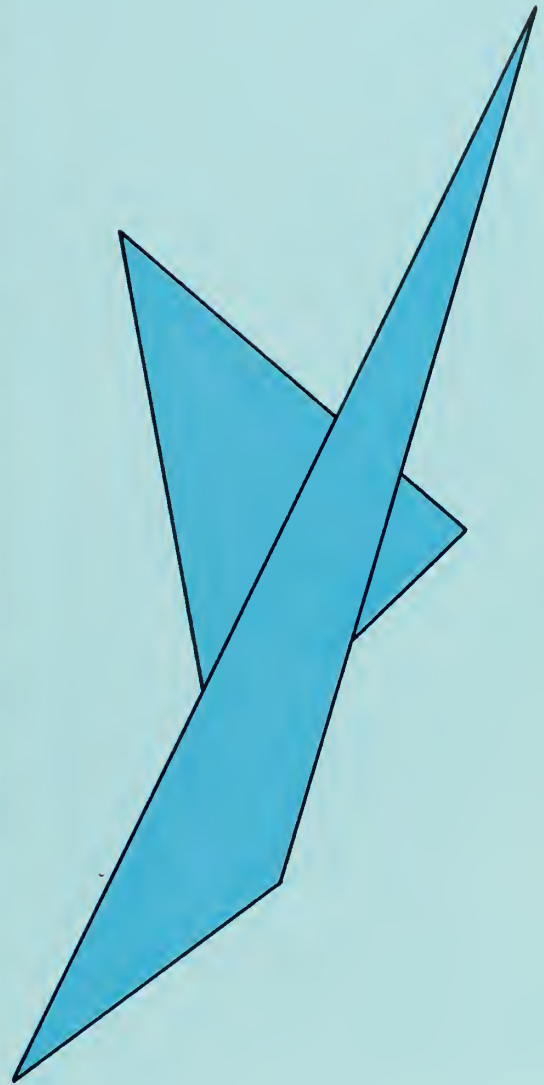

The 1964 REFLECTOR has tried to recapture a few of these familiar moments for you, hoping that they will help you to recall at least part of the spirit of Georgia Southern.

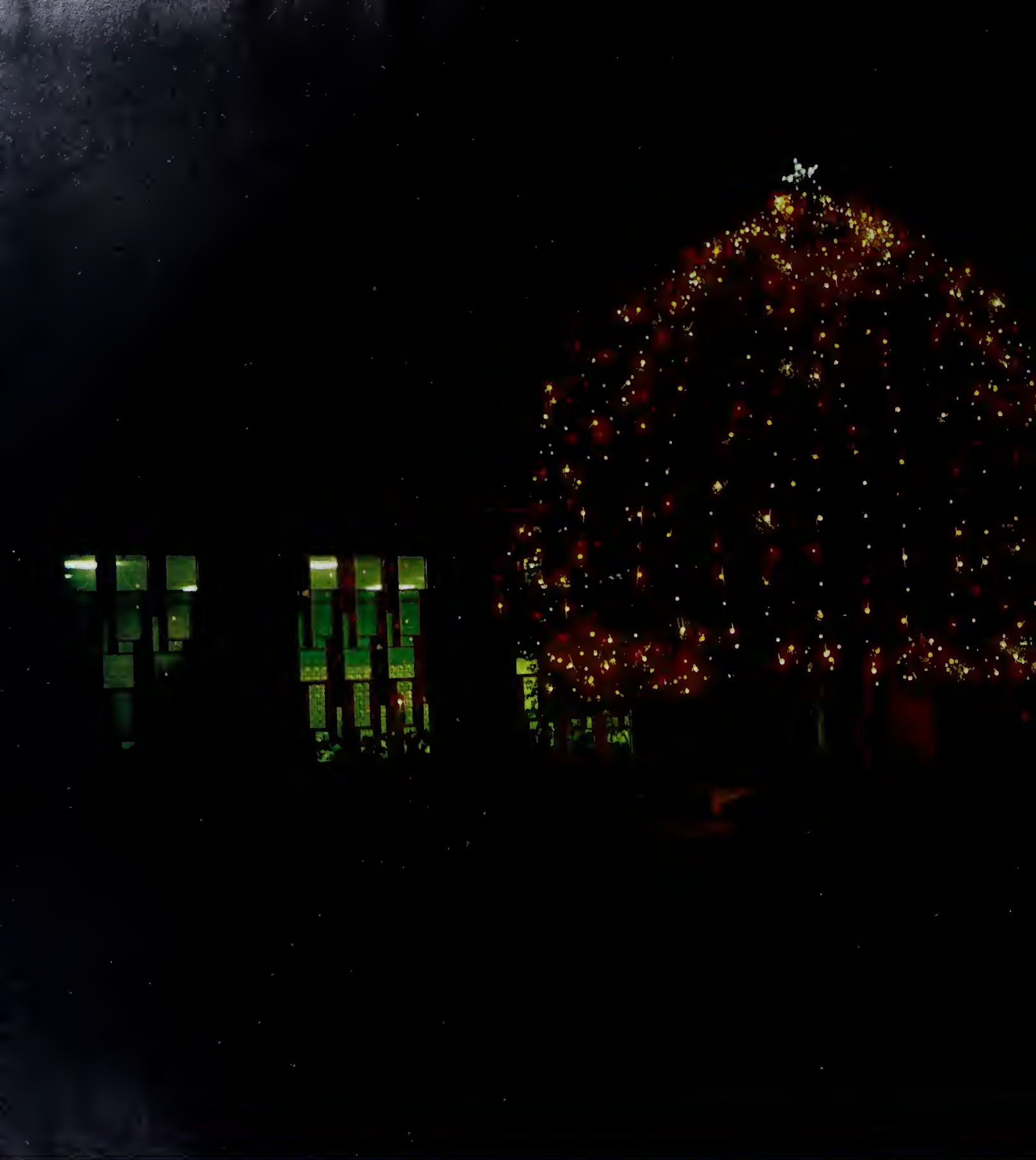
