

### Strong Doubles Leads No. 3 Men's Tennis To 6-3 Win Over No. 2 Saint Leo

**SAVANNAH, Ga.** - The No. 3-ranked Armstrong State University men's tennis team used strong doubles play to pick up a 6-3 win over No. 2-ranked Saint Leo University on Sunday afternoon at the Armstrong Tennis Complex.

The Pirates (4-1) also downed a Saint Leo team that knocked Armstrong State out of the NCAA Semifinals last May. The Lions (3-1) suffered their first loss of the season. Armstrong State returns to action on Friday, February 24th, opening up Peach Belt play with a 1:00 p.m. match at USC Aiken.

Armstrong State swept all three doubles matches from the Lions to build a 3-0 lead as No. 5-ranked **Alberto Caceres Casas** and **Jan Porteset** downed Thomas Grinberg and Vincent Suillerot, 8-6, at No. 1 doubles. The duo of **Lorenzo Camilli** and **Bjorn Kurtze** upset the No. 8-ranked duo of Jamie Bueno and Oskar Nurmio, 8-6, at No. 2 doubles, while **Ignacio Hernandez** and Alvaro Cruz Chomorro defeated Francisco Aparicio and Charles Benet, 8-5, at No. 3 doubles.

Each team then picked up three singles wins as the Pirates closed out the 6-3 victory. No. 22-ranked Hernandez downed

Aparicio, 6-2, 6-4, at No. 4 singles for Armstrong State, while Cruz Chomorro beat Benet, 7-5, 6-3, at No. 5 singles and Camilli beat Willem Van Den Akker, 6-3, 4-6, (10-5) at No. 6 singles.

For Saint Leo, Thomas Grinberg downed Kurtze, 6-2, 6-3, at No. 1 singles, while Suillerot beat Porteset, 6-4, 6-3, at No. 2 singles. Bueno notched the win over No. 4-ranked Caceres Casas when he was disqualified in the middle of the second set, leading at that point 6-4, 4-4.
