One of the purposes of this society is to honor those who attain excellence in the study of the Spanish language and in the study of the literature and culture of the Spanish-speaking peoples.

Several Spanish language students, and the Spanish faculty of the Department of Foreign Languages from both campuses, Armstrong and Statesboro, will attend the ceremony. Emily Pressler and Jordan Clarke, two recently initiated members, will conduct the ceremony, which will be followed by a reception. A certificate, a pin, and a red carnation will be distributed among the neophytes during the ceremony as symbols of their entry into the society.
