I am very pleased to announce that Dr. Melanie Miller has accepted my request to serve as Interim Vice President for Student Affairs, beginning on May 1 when Dr. Georj Lewis becomes Interim President of Atlanta Metropolitan State University.

As many of you know, Dr. Miller's tenure in higher education spans more than two decades at several institutions. She holds a bachelor's degree in social welfare, a Master of Arts in Community Counseling, and her Ed.D. in Higher Education Administration from the University of Alabama. Prior to beginning her work in higher education, her experience included work within the mental health field and work with community-based, non-profit agencies.
