The 2018 Blue and White spring football game was one of the most anticipated spring games in a while for Georgia Southern.

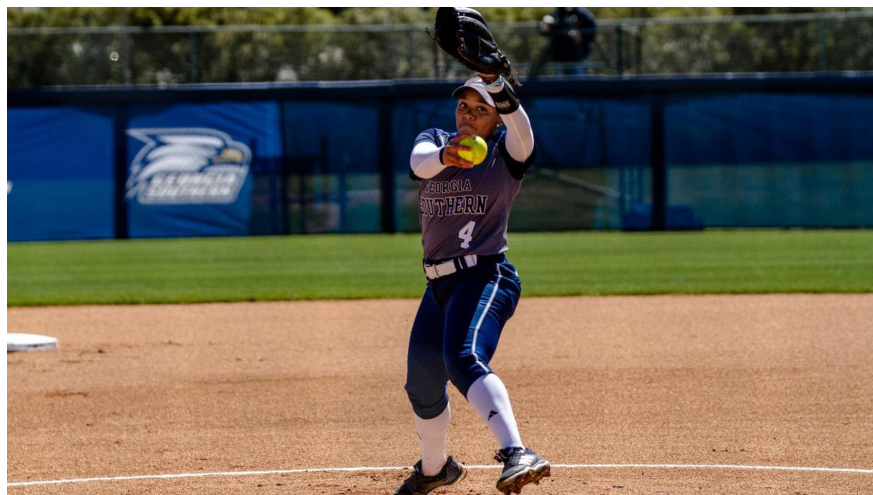
With about 1000 fans in attendance, the Blue team (defense) was victorious over the White team (offense) with a score of 47-38. [Full Story](#).
