RN to BSN Program Ranked No. 4 in Georgia

Georgia Southern University's online RN to BSN program has been ranked No. 4 for the [Best Online RN to BSN Programs in Georgia for 2021](#). *RegisteredNursing.org* evaluated nursing programs in Georgia based on accreditation status, program format, tuition and fees, number of tenured faculty, graduation rate, and acceptance rate.

RN to BSN programs allow those currently working as a registered nurse in Georgia the opportunity to upgrade their registered nurse credential with a Bachelor of Science in Nursing degree. Designed with the flexibility to work around life and work schedules, Georgia Southern's RN to BSN program can be completed in less than 12 months. The program consists of eight online courses that provide nurses with the knowledge and expertise required by the complex and ever-evolving healthcare environment.
