Georgia Southern teacher prep programs earn highest scores on state effectiveness measures



Georgia Southern University earned a Level 4 rating, the highest available score, on the 2021 Teacher Preparation Program Effectiveness Measures (PPEMs) published by the Georgia Professional Standards Commission (GaPSC).

The PPEMs evaluate educator preparation programs using measures collected during candidates' time in the program, such as certification assessments required by the state and measures collected following completion once candidates are in the classroom. This includes classroom observations by supervisors as well as surveys of employers and newly employed teachers. The primary purpose of the PPEMs is to give educator preparation programs detailed information they can use to improve.
