 - a. Faculty Welfare OWG: Faculty Evaluation Recommendations
 - i. T and P Transition Recommendation: Senate President: We have attached a proposal to submit this recommendation for consideration by the faculty welfare OWG. Biology made some suggestions for changes. Can anyone from Biology speak about the proposed additions?
Response from Senator: No.
Comment from Senate President: We cannot vote on this because we don't have quorum.
Comment from Senator: We are having an issue about this in our department. Right now the course load question is being delayed for one of our colleagues is because this hasn't been decided.
Question from Senate President: Can you email those concerns and who is being affected?
Response from Senator: Yes.
Comment from Senator: This wording was generated in our College Policy Committee. Since we came to a relatively quick consensus, it seemed worth forwarding to the faculty welfare committee or faculty welfare OWG, as we heard they had not passed a university

policy on T&P transition and, therefore, had not approved wording to send to the CIC.

Comment from CIC representative: That is correct.
