Sarah Fonseca wins 2014 Harbuck Award

Final judge [Peter Cashwell](#) has chosen Sarah Fonseca as the winner of this year's Harbuck Scholarship Award. T.J. Morgan and Aleya Rentz are the two finalists.

Twenty-one writing majors were nominated and 14 applied for the award. The Harbuck Committee, comprising Professors Laura Valeri, Emma Bolden, and Eric Nelson, agree that this year's entries were among the strongest they have ever received and that narrowing the field to three finalists to send on to Cashwell was a difficult decision.

Sarah will receive her award at the annual Harbuck Scholarship Award Reading and Reception, Friday, September 12, at 7 p.m. in the Allen E. Paulson College of Engineering and Information Technology, Room 1005.

Cashwell is author of *The Verb 'To Bird'* and *Along Those Lines* and will give a reading from his work in conjunction with the award ceremony Thursday, September 11, at 7 p.m. in CEIT, Room 1005.
