For the fifth time in eight years of eligibility, Georgia Southern is headed to an NCAA postseason bowl game. Georgia Southern will meet Buffalo (6-6) Camellia Bowl at noon (ET)/11 a.m. (local) on Tuesday, Dec. 27 at the Historic Cramton Bowl. The game will be televised nationally by ESPN.

The Camellia Bowl will mark the first football meeting between GS and Buffalo.

Tickets to the Camellia Bowl will go on sale to all of Eagle Nation, both online and via phone, beginning at 9 a.m. (ET) on Monday, Dec. 5.
