THE CONVICT CAMPS.

Many Evidences of Mismanagement.

Atlanta, March 17.—Gov. Canfield is very much wrought up over the accumulating evidences of mismanagement of the convict camps in many of the counties of the state, and it is not at all unlikely that he will send a special messenger to the legislature on the subject at the beginning of the next session.

In fact it may be that he will send an investigation in some quarters before the legislature meets. This step was taken, as well as will be remembered in the case of the McRee camp in Lowndes county, and it is very probable that several other investigations will be instituted by the Prison Commission within the next two weeks.

Stories of abuse and mismanagement are constantly being brought to the attention of the Prison Commission. It is frequently the case that complaints of kidnapping come from different sources. It is not a month since the Governor had such a case before him. A negro discharged from one convict camp was arrested on an alleged escape and put to work in another camp. The result was the negro was promptly released and paid for the time he had worked.
