Large picture - "What is your favorite season?" - done by Ms. Cowart's second grade class

Six posters - collections of photographs of activities at MPLS during the last year

Fourteen large pictures with descriptions of future civilizations by student groups at MPLS (no mention of teacher or grade level)

Four large pictures of "Ocean Environment" by students in Ms. Gantt's class
