Censuses

Bulloch County Census 1820-1870

- This file contains a notebook with handwritten transcriptions of information in Bulloch County Censuses taken between 1820 and 1870.

Burke County Census

- This file contains handwritten notes taken from Burke County Censuses taken between the years 1820 and 1880.

Emanuel County Census 1850

- This file contains typewritten notes on the family of John "Ready Money" Johnson, with one of the sources cited being the Emanuel County Census for 1850.

Jefferson - See Warren County

- This file contains handwritten notes taken from 19th-century Jefferson County records.

Screven County Census 1860

- This file contains handwritten transcripts of the Screven County Census for 1860.

Stewart County Census 1850

- This file contains typed and handwritten transcripts of information in the Stewart County Census for 1850.
