ABOUT THE COLLECTION

Administrative History: The American Committee for Irish Studies held its first conference in December 1961. In 1987 the name of the organization was changed to American Conference for Irish Studies. The American Conference for Irish Studies (ACIS) exists to encourage research and writing in Irish Studies by establishing a means of communication between scholars interested in Irish Studies in all disciplines, and to promote Irish Studies as a legitimate and distinct course of studies in American colleges, universities and secondary schools, and to further the development and dissemination of research, teaching and scholarly and critical inquiry in Irish Studies.

The organization hosts a national conference annually, alternating between the United States and Ireland. It also hosts five regional conferences each year including ACIS-South, the Southern Chapter of the American Conference for Irish studies.

Scope and Content: This collection consists of records of the Southern Chapter of the American Conference for Irish Studies. Materials include correspondence, meeting programs and minutes, reports, and membership lists. Much of the material concerns the annual meeting and other activities of the organization from 1989 to 2014.

System of Arrangement: The collection is arranged in a hierarchical structure and in chronological order.
