0000 - Beginning

0055 - Chasing rabbits, planting trees, cutting down trees

0500 - Cane mill location

0550 - Going down to mow near a house

0700 - Movement, looking for bricks from a chimney

1133 - Mapping out where people lived in South Georgia, Uriah Rogers and family

1500 - Placing grave slabs with concrete, exploring a cemetery

1750 - Curtis airplanes, rain

1825 - Cane boiler location, orchard, cotton gin, English walnuts, pecans, fruit and peach trees.

Parts of the family plantation

2100 - Railroads, lumber industry, Georgia Pacific

2210 - Property inheritance

2340 - Kitchen, smokehouses

2690 - Barns and interiors of houses

3000 - Movement in a vehicle, Dr. Kilday's horses

3210 - Steam engines as power source for cotton gin, community gins

3400 - Homeschooling with tutor

3585 - Iron fence, Stories about Uriah

3790 - Old bridge into Bulloch County. Kicklighters across the river.

3965 - Finding a photograph of Uriah's house

4060 - Cousins of Dr. Kilday

4125 - Losing everything in the Great Depression, dividing the property through inheritance

4200 - Drawing for land property in inheritance

4300 - Hotel owned by Dr. Kilday's father and uncle near the property, burned due to the flue not having a cap on it

4470 - Teaching school down in Florida

4540 - Turpentine business

4630 - Cotton crop on the property. 13 bales of cotton on 12 acres of land.

4790 - Dr. Kilday in charge of buying land for timber for Georgia Pacific.

4873 - End
