ABOUT THE COLLECTION

Biographical History: Rebecca Ziegler was a Reference Librarian and Associate Professor at Georgia Southern University's Zach S. Henderson Library from 1990 - 2017. During that time, she served as the Library Liaison for literature, philosophy, religion, writing and linguistics, art, interior design, apparel design and fashion merchandising, and Irish studies.

Zeigler holds degrees from the University of Chicago (B.A.) and the University of California, Los Angeles (M.A., Ph.D., and M.L.S.). Over the years, she served on many faculty committees at Georgia Southern, including a stint on the Faculty Senate and the Senate Executive Committee. She also served on state and national professional committees for the Association of College and Research Libraries, and the Georgia Library Association. Ziegler was a founding member of the Georgia International Conference on Information Literacy. A prolific scholar with diverse interests, she earned a Fulbright Fellowship to study at Universität Freiburg im Breisgau, West Germany, and has given more than fifty conference presentations in the areas of librarianship, literature, art, and religious studies. She is also a poet and has had her artwork displayed in local galleries.

Scope and Content: This collection consists of exhibition materials researched and prepared by Rebecca Zeigler from her work as a reference librarian at Georgia Southern University's Zach S. Henderson Library. Materials span 1990 - 2016 and cover a range of subjects.
