ABOUT THE COLLECTION

Administrative History: The Ogeechee-Canoochee Riverkeeper (ORK) was formed in 2004 from the merger of two organizations, Canoochee Riverkeeper (CRK) and Friends of the Ogeechee River (FROG). The goal of ORK is to protect rivers and streams throughout the Ogeechee basin from nutrient overloading, groundwater contamination, and a host of other pollution threats. The merger was made official in 2005, and the new name was chosen. In 2009, the name was shortened to Ogeechee Riverkeeper. The Ogeechee Oral History project, funded by Ogeechee Riverkeeper beginning in 2016, was carried out by c.a.s.e. Consulting Services, LLC. Materials were collected from Simona Perry of c.a.s.e Consulting Services, LLC. The Ogeechee Project was designed to document and create collaborative initiatives to preserve and share the history of the people who live along and use the Ogeechee River in Georgia. This collection covers the records of Phase I from the ORK Ogeechee Project.

Scope and Content: This collection consists of oral history interviews of people who grew up living on the Ogeechee River and its watershed. The interviews were conducted from 2016-2017 for Phase I of the Ogeechee Project, but the topics span a broad range of time - including family lore and artifacts from Native American settlement and the Colonial Period through today. Materials include photographs and written documents with audio recordings making the bulk of the collection. Materials were originally collected by c.a.s.e. Consulting Services for the Ogeechee Riverkeeper organization,
