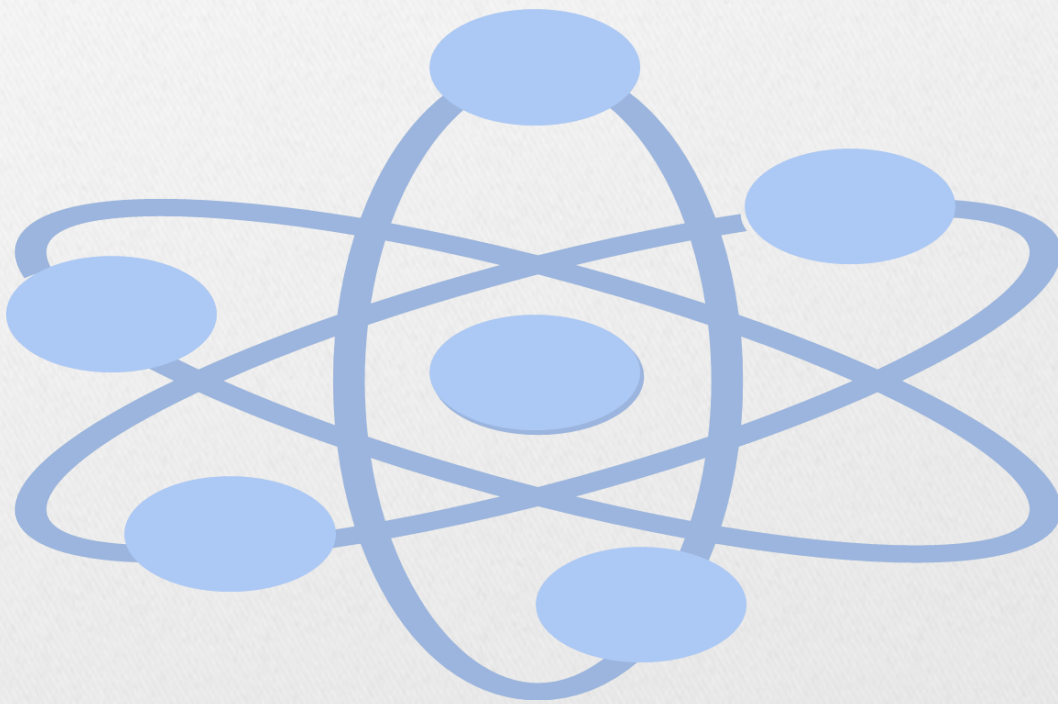

---

**Genius Hour** – a strategy that allows anyone to explore their own passions.

- It encourages creativity in the classroom
- It provides students a choice in what they learn during a set time period

**Google Arts & Culture** – a one stop shop for fascinating virtual interactive viewing of over 2000 leading museums and archives from all angles 360 degrees

- Anyone, not just art and history lovers can explore these readily by searching Themes, Mediums, Historic Events, Names of Artists, and Places



# Quarantine Queries

## A Librarian's 5G Inclusive Reveal

---

**Global Oneness Project** – an interdisciplinary, multimedia platform catering to environmental, cultural and social issues:

- It is a **free**, no ads multicultural collection of films, photo essays, and articles from around the world
- It is aligned to National and Common Core Standards

**Google Reverse Image Search** – involves choosing an image and using Google Search Engine to find the same image on other websites for free. Some practical uses:

- Find any duplicated content.
- Identify the source information for an image
- Check compliance with copyright
- Uncover faked images
- Discover higher resolution versions of an image

## A Librarian's 5G Inclusive Reveal

---

**GarageBand** – a digital audio workstation app for iOS and macOS devices that allows users to:

- Create music or podcasts and much more
- Explore multitrack recording, composition, and sound design
- Develop creativity and ensemble skills
- Have a great deal of freedom in creating their own compositions

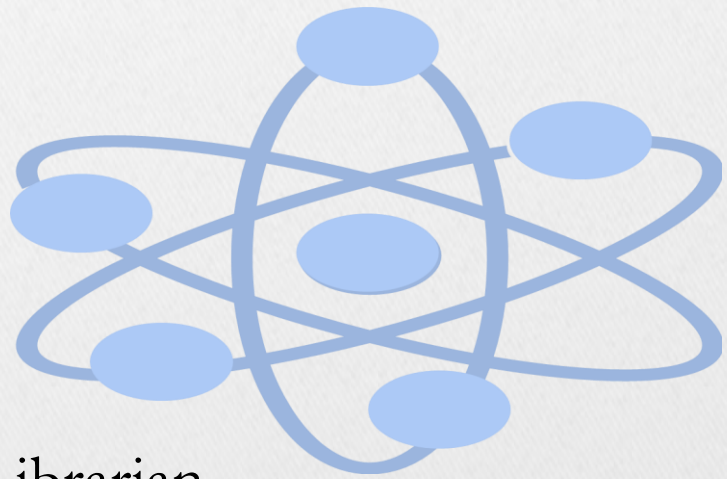
