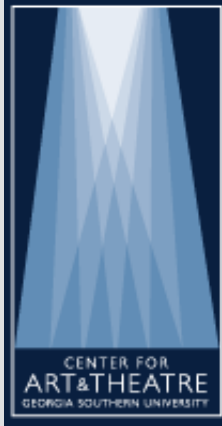

wonder in the familiar. **Eccentric Grids: Mapping the Managed Forest: Enumeration and Density** is part of an ongoing project that investigates the ubiquitous pine ecosystems of the South. Gladdys combines small format video and installation, creating a visualization that compares the tree density of managed commercial pine plantations over time with the “trunkprint” of old growth longleaf pine forests.

Katerie Gladdys is an associate professor in Art and Technology in the School of Art and Art History at the University of Florida. She examines place, marginalized landscapes, sustainability, mapping, consumption, food, agriculture, and disability creating installations, interactive, sculpture, video, and relational performances.
