All University of Chicago Press Journals Now Available on New Platform

As part of consolidation, all campuses now have access to all University of Chicago Press journals via the University of Chicago Press Journals database. This database provides access to over 70 scholarly publications that cover a wide range of disciplines, from the humanities and the social sciences to the life and physical sciences. American Doctoral Dissertations, 1933-1955 Is Now OpenDissertations

OpenDissertations, formerly American Doctoral Dissertations 1933-1955, is a free electronic theses and dissertations database offering access to more than 800,000 electronic theses and dissertations.

OpenDissertations extends the work started in 2014, when EBSCO and the H.W. Wilson Foundation created American Doctoral Dissertations, which contained indexing from the H.W. Wilson print publication, Doctoral Dissertations Accepted by American Universities, 1933-1955. In 2015, the H.W. Wilson Foundation agreed to support the expansion of the scope of the American Doctoral Dissertations database to include records for dissertations and theses from 1955 to the present.

HathiTrust Digital Library Is Now Available Via the A-Z Database List

HathiTrust Digital Library is a partnership of research institutions and libraries that preserves and provides access to digitized content from library collections. HathiTrust includes content under copyright as well as public domain items that have been digitized by Google, the Internet Archive, Microsoft, and library initiatives.

“Full View” items may be viewed by anyone since they are no longer protected by copyright or have been given open access permission.

“Limited (search only)” items are still under copyright protection. Although they can't be viewed online through the HathiTrust, you are searching their contents when you do a search. If you find something of interest, check the library's GIL-Find catalog to locate it at Georgia Southern or another University of Georgia System library. If the item is not listed in GIL-Find, you may be able to borrow it through Interlibrary Loan.

HeinOnline – Trial Now Available through December 14, 2018

This summer and fall, the University Libraries is conducting a trial of [HeinOnline](#). This resource is available to the University community through December 14, 2018.

[HeinOnline](#) is the world's largest fully searchable, image-based government document and legal research database. It contains comprehensive coverage from inception of both U.S. statutory materials, U.S. Congressional Documents and more than 2,500 scholarly journals, all of the world's constitutions, all U.S. treaties, collections of classic treatises and presidential documents, and access to the full text of state and federal case law powered by Fastcase. This [Government, Politics & Law](#) HeinOnline 18-database package offers special collections on Criminal Justice, Religion and the Law and Women and the Law among others.
